1 Using Non-ASCII Characters

You should not include non-ASCII characters in the data service name. Oracle Data Service Integrator may fail to deploy the web service when the physical data service name contains non-ASCII characters.

2 Including a Commit Operation within a Stored Procedure

When using a data service with a relational datasource, you cannot include a commit operation within a stored procedure.

3 Using Data Lineage Applet

Due to browser security settings, the Data Lineage applet will not work when using Mozilla Firefox or Google Chrome browsers. You should use Internet Explorer browser to view Data Lineage.

4 Deleting User Accounts

When you delete a user account, be sure to delete the corresponding account privileges as well. If you do not, if a new user with an identical name, the new user will receive all the privileges of the previously deleted user.
