1 General Issues and Workarounds

The following lists additional support and options provided by Oracle9iAS XML Developer's Kits (XDKs) Release 2 (9.0.2):

- Oracle Schema Processor now supports the official W3C Schema Recommendation.
- XSQL Servlet now provides support for Apache FOP 0.18.
- SourceViewer Bean now supports internal DTDs.
- XSQL Servlet:
 - Now supports the setting of multiple parameter values with a single SQL statement.
 - Provides a new performance improvement option for <xsql:include-owa>.
 - Has a new Airport SOAP Service demo.
 - Now supports the simplified inclusion of XML from CLOB's and VARCHAR2 columns.
- XSQL Processor
XSLT Processor for Java is now threadsafe.
