Installation Updates

When installing Oracle Strategic Operational Planning, you must also install the following third party applications:

- JDK 1.5 (downloaded from java.sun.com)
- Microsoft JDBC driver version 1.1 (if using Microsoft SQL server as your dbserver)

Known Issues

- If the Excel client crashes during operation, the last session state layout is not saved. The initial layout goes back to the default layout.
- In Excel 2000, when switching to a different application during a long query, Excel sometimes crashes. The workaround is to stay focused on Excel and wait until the Oracle Strategic Operational Planning query completes successfully.

Tips and Troubleshooting

Symptom:

Excel does not launch.

Solutions:

- In Excel, select **Tools > Macros > Security**. Go to **Trusted Publishers** and select **Trust all installed add-ins and templates**.
- **(Excel 2003 only)**: In Excel, select **Help > About Microsoft Excel** and select **Disabled Items** for Ambassador. If it is already selected, select it again.
- In Add/Remove Programs, uninstall Oracle Strategic Operational Planning Excel. (You may have to close all Microsoft Office applications including Outlook and Internet Explorer.)
- In Internet Explorer, select **Tools > Internet Options**; then, delete cookies and files.
