

# Oracle® Retail Store Inventory Management

Release Notes

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This Release Notes document is the only component of the SIM 13.2.0.1 release. The purpose of this Release Notes document is to correct the *Oracle Retail Store Inventory Management Installation Guide* for Release 13.2.

## Documentation Release Only

The Oracle Retail Store Inventory Management (SIM) 13.2.0.1 release is a documentation-only release. There is no code associated with this release identifier. SIM 13.2 remains the current version of the code.

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**Notes:** This Release Notes document specifically corrects the networking and compatibility requirements stated in the *Oracle Retail Store Inventory Management Installation Guide* for Release 13.2.

## Check Client PC and Web Browser Requirements

Requirement	Version
Operating System	Windows 2000 or XP
Database Server	Oracle Database 10g Release 2 Enterprise Edition (minimum 10.2.0.4.0 patchset required) with the following patches and components:
Display Resolution	1024x768 or higher
Processor	1GHz or higher
Memory	512MBytes or higher
Networking	intranet with at least 10Mbps data rate
Sun Java Runtime Environment	5.0 Update 11 or newer (1.5.0_11)
Browser	Microsoft Internet Explorer version 5.5 or higher The browser is used to launch the Java WebStart client.

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**Note:** Oracle Retail does not recommend or support installations with less than 128 kb bandwidth available between the PC client and the data center. Limiting the client to less than 128 kb total available bandwidth causes unpredictable network utilization spikes, and performance of the client degrades below requirements established for the product.

The 128 kb requirement provides reasonable, predictable performance and network utilization.

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## Oracle Retail Dependencies

The following Oracle Retail products can be integrated with SIM. Next to each product is an indication of whether it is required or optional for SIM to function properly:

- Oracle Retail Integration Bus (RIB) 13.1.1 and all subsequent patches and hot fixes - Required

RIBforSIM is a separately-packaged component that connects SIM to the RIB. Although typically used to integrate SIM with RMS, RIB can also be used to integrate SIM with other merchandising systems.

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**Note:** RIB requires custom modifications to use a merchandising system other than RMS.

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**Note:** Defect 9131352 Dependency

This defect includes a change in RIB jars and the fix has to be downloaded and applied from patch 9076352.

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- Oracle Retail Merchandising System (RMS) 13.1.1 - Optional
- Oracle Retail Service Layer (RSL) 13.1.1 - Optional

The above products can be installed before or after SIM. However, it is helpful to know the connection details for the other products ahead of time so that you can provide them to the SIM application installer, which will configure the connection points for you.

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
