Noteworthy Defect Fixes

The following defects have been fixed in this release:

- **8705064** – When reports were generated, an out of memory issue occurred because of the implicit statement caching. This issue has been resolved.
- **11929354** – When weeks within the same fiscal month fall into both December and January calendar months, the Recommended Forecast and What-if screens display all months sequentially.
- **12332630** – The escalation logic for the seasonality overrides are changed such that exact matches to a particular season code are favored over wildcard (%) matches at any given level. This prevents the incorrect behavior of "cascading" overrides. This better matches the escalation logic typically employed in the APC lookups.
- **12406486** – A validation has been added to the No Touch Between business rule. It ensures that the value set is always in a range between 1 through 100. Setting the value to 1 will ensure that the items are eligible for consecutive recommendations, provided there are a minimum of seven days between the effective dates.
- **12406401** – The value `#{dbms.oracle.user}` for the `database.auditdb.oracle.auth.auditoracleauth.password` parameter in the `price.install.properties` file was incorrect and caused errors during the installation. The parameter value in the `price.install.properties` file has been updated to reflect the correct value, `#{dbms.oracle.pass}`.
