The Sun Management Center 2.1.1 console will not load these modules unless the required parameters are specified. It is possible to load the modules without specifying the required parameters by using the Client API's `loadModule` method — however, a module loaded this way is not guaranteed to function correctly. It is the Client API user's responsibility to verify that the required parameters are specified before passing them to the `loadModule` method.
