Chapter 1. General

Known Issues

The SNMP agent on L-Series libraries will answer any SNMP request regardless of the community property when configured with a `public` community.

The SNMP value for free cell count is not reported in the properties of L20, L40, and L80 libraries with an embedded SNMP agent.

New Functions

The StorageTek Framework Library Monitor version 4.3 provides the following new functions:

- Starting from firmware level 2.12.06, embedded agents for L20, L40, and L80 libraries are supported.
- ACSLS agents 2.0 working with ACSLS Server 7.0 are supported.
- StorageTek Framework Library Monitor can now retrieve the framework SNMP configuration—whether it be node-specific or global to the network—that is appropriate to perform SNMP requests.
