Release Notes

Oracle Preventive Controls Governor (PCG) is a set of four applications that run, and implement controls, within instances of Oracle E-Business Suite. These applications include:

- Form Rules, which modifies the security, navigation, field, and data properties of Oracle EBS forms.
- Flow Rules, which defines and implements business processes.
- Audit Rules, which tracks changes to the values of fields in database tables that underlie Oracle EBS.
- Change Control, which regulates changes to the values of fields in Oracle EBS forms.

In the background, PCG provides “Access Approvals” functionality employed by a separately installed product, Application Access Controls Governor.

Version 7.3.3 of PCG resolves the following issues:

PCG version 7.3.3 can be installed only as an upgrade to version 7.3.2.

Libraries of change-control rules are available for use with Preventive Controls Governor when it is applied to an Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.1 or 11.5.10.2 instance. There are twelve content files, one for each of the languages supported by PCG. In addition, an *Installation Guide* and a *User Guide* document procedures for upgrading and using PCG. The content libraries and the documentation are unchanged from the 7.3.2 release.
