

- Timesheet line approval



Internationalization Enhancements

Instantis EnterpriseTrack 8.6 is now available in 11 languages, supported on client operating systems and browsers that are normally supported in English. The languages are enabled through the admin user interface during installation or post-installation. Languages are:

- English
- Spanish
- German
- French
- Brazilian Portuguese
- Italian
- Japanese
- Korean
- Russian
- Simplified Chinese
- Traditional Chinese



Custom configurations such as user-defined field prompts, activity type names, e-mail subject lines, etc. can be extracted and translated. You can either export just the altered strings in XLIFF file format for bulk translation by an agency, or update minor translations through the Language Catalog. Please note:

- English is the only primary language and needs to be enabled for all deployments.
- Client Microsoft Project and PowerPoint integrations are not supported with non-English languages.


Benefits:

- Provides more successful international deployments in non-English-speaking regions.
- Provides better local and legal regulation conformance with out of the box standard production translations.

User Interface Enhancements

Instantis Enterprise Track 8.6 user interface has been revised with a new color scheme and navigation style. While EnterpriseTrack's menus and other interface elements remain in their usual locations, the look of the interface has been updated as follows:

- **Login page:** Color scheme is changed to align with other Oracle Primavera products.
- **Left Navigation:** Icons are updated and there is a toggle menu to display either icons only or icons and text.
- **Title Bar and Header:** Header is redesigned to align with other Oracle Primavera products.

Timesheet Line Approval

Instantis EnterpriseTrack 8.6 now includes the option to approve timesheets at the line level, enabling project managers to approve project and activity time line items as they relate to a project. Resource managers can approve non-project time line items such as vacation, sick and general administrative tasks. Project managers and resource managers can approve line items in the same timesheet at the same time. The timesheet is approved when all line items are approved.
