# 1. Upgrade Prerequisites

---

The following table lists the pre-requisites for upgrading Oracle Revenue Management and Billing from one version to another. It indicates the following:

- Whether you need to upgrade the framework before upgrading the application.
- Whether there are any pre-requisites or post-requisites (additional single fixes) for upgrading the framework.
- Whether you need to upgrade any third party software before upgrading the framework.
- Whether data should be migrated while upgrading Oracle Revenue Management and Billing from one version to another.

You must migrate data only after you have successfully upgraded the database. To migrate data from V2.3.0.0.0 to V2.3.0.1.0, refer to the Data Migration section in the *Oracle Revenue Management and Billing Upgrade Guide*.
