1 OFS AAI Release v8.0.8.6.0

OFS Analytical Applications Infrastructure Installation Guide (OFS AAI) Maintenance Level (ML) release v8.0.8.6.0 includes all the bug fixes and minor enhancements done since the previous GA (General Availability) release v8.0.8.0.0.

This ML release of OFS AAI can be installed on a setup with any Oracle Financial Services Analytical Applications (OFSAA) v8.0.8.0.0 Application Pack.

1.2 Pre-installation Requirements

The following are the pre-installation requirements for OFS AAI Release 8.0.8.6.0:

- The minimum patch level installed must be OFS AAI Release **8.0.8.0.0**.
- OFS AAI Release v8.0.8.6.0 is compatible with WebLogic 12.2.x and does not support WebLogic 12.1.3. If the WebLogic version is 12.1.3, upgrade to WebLogic 12.2.x.
- Ensure that the unlimited cryptographic policy for Java is enabled during the installation of OFS AAI 8.0.8.0.0.

For more information, see the *Enabling Unlimited Cryptographic Policy* section in the OFS Analytical Applications Infrastructure Administration Guide.

- It is mandatory to install the OFSAAI 8.0.8.6.0 ML only on *Java 8 with JCE enabled*. Therefore, configure the Java version of the following to *Java 8 with JCE enabled*.
 - OFSAA Processing Tier (where the ML will be installed)
 - Web server (Tomcat/WebSphere/WebLogic)

NOTE

To upgrade Java 7 in an existing OFSAA 8.0.8.x.x instance to Java 8, see *Appendix P* in the <u>Oracle Financial Services</u> <u>Analytical Applications Infrastructure Installation and Configuration Guide</u>.

1.2.1 Oracle Database 19c Server and Client Support

The OFSAA 8.0.8.6.x release supports Oracle Database 19c in addition to the continued support on Oracle Database 12c.

NOTE

The <u>Oracle Database 19c Server Configuration</u> and <u>Oracle Database 19c Client Configuration</u> sections apply to upgrade installation of OFS AAI and the <u>New Installation of OFSAA 8.0.8.0.0 with Oracle Database 19c</u> section applies to a new installation of OFS AAI.

1.2.1.1 Oracle Database 19c Server Configuration

To configure the Oracle Database 19c server if the OFS AAI version is 8.0.8.x.x, follow these prerequisite steps:

1. Stop all the OFS AAI services.

For more information, see the Starting/Stopping Infrastructure Services section in the <u>Oracle Financial Services Analytical Applications Infrastructure Installation and Configuration Guide</u>.

- 2. Back up the tnsnames.ora file from the existing OFSAA Processing Tier <code>\$ORACLE_HOME</code> directory.
- 3. Upgrade the existing Oracle Database 12c or 18c server to the Oracle Database 19c server.

 If there are challenges in the upgrade, configure a new instance of the Oracle Database 19c server and follow these steps:
 - **a.** Ensure to restore all the schemas from the Oracle Database 12c or 18c instance to the 19c instance using the Oracle DB Data Pump feature.
 - **b.** Modify the .profile file of the OFSAA Processing Tier for the ORACLE_SID environment variable to the Oracle Database 19C PDB (Pluggable Database) Service Name.
 - c. Modify the JDBC URL of the new Oracle Database 19c server using the **Portc** utility.

1.2.1.2 Oracle Database 19c Client Configuration

To configure the Oracle Database 19c client if the OFS AAI version is 8.0.8.x.x, follow these prerequisite steps:

- 1. Install the Oracle Database 19c client on the OFSAA Processing Tier.
- **2.** Modify the .profile file of the OFSAA Processing Tier for the \$ORACLE_HOME environment variable to point to the Oracle Database 19c client home directory.
- 3. Modify the tnsnames.ora file to point to the new Oracle Database 19c instance.

1.2.1.3 New Installation of OFSAA 8.0.8.0.0 with Oracle Database 19c

To Install the OFSAA 8.0.8.0.0 base installer with Oracle Database 19c, follow the instructions in the My Oracle Support note <u>Doc ID 2691006.1</u> and then upgrade to OFSAA 8.0.8.6.0.

1.3 How to Install this Release

To install the release patch, follow these steps:

- 1. Log in to My Oracle Support and search for **34041048** under the **Patches & Updates** tab.
- 2. Download the OFSAA 8.0.8.6.0 OFS AAI ML Release archive file and copy it to your OFSAA server in **Binary** mode.

NOTE

There are different archive files for different operating systems such as AIX, Solaris, and RHEL/OEL.

- 3. Search and download the mandatory patch 33918437 from My Oracle Support.
- **4.** Stop all the OFS AAI services.

5. Log in to the OFSAA server as a non-root user and navigate to the \$FIC HOME directory.

6. Assign WRITE permission to the files/directories such as commonscripts, EXEWebService, ficapp, ficweb, and ficdb, using the command:

```
chmod -R 775 *
```

- 7. If you have the Unzip utility, skip to the next step or download the Unzip utility (OS-specific) and copy it in Binary mode to the directory that is included in your PATH variable, typically \$HOME path or directory in which you have copied the 8.0.8.6.0 ML.
 - Uncompress the unzip installer file using the command:

```
uncompress unzip_<os>.Z
```

NOTE

If you notice an error message "uncompress: not found [No such file or directory]" when the package is not installed, contact your UNIX administrator.

• Give EXECUTE permission to the utility using the command:

```
chmod 751 unzip_<os>
```

For example, chmod 751 unzip_aix

8. Extract the contents of the 8.0.8.6.0 ML archive file using one of the following commands:

```
unzip_<os> -a <name of the file to be unzipped>
Or
unzip -a <name of the file to be unzipped>
```

NOTE

The above "-a" option is mandatory to unzip the archive file. For example: For the AIX operating system, unzip aix -a p34041048 80860 AIX64.zip

9. Navigate to the path where the folder OFS_AAI exists to give EXECUTE permission to the ML patch installer script using the command:

```
chmod 755 OFSAAIUpdate.sh
```

10. Complete the patch upgrade using the command:

```
./OFSAAIUpdate.sh
```

11. Verify if the ML patch is applied successfully by checking the log file generated in the OFS_AAI/logs directory. You can ignore error codes ORA-00001, ORA-00955, ORA-01430, and ORA-02292 in the log file.

For any other errors, contact My Oracle Support.

NOTE

For an upgrade on Hive Infodom, you may encounter an exception "PL/SQL: ORA-00942: table or view does not exist". You can ignore this error.

- **12.** After the successful installation of the ML, follow these steps:
 - Execute .profile using the following command:
 - . \$HOME/.profile
 - Clear the application cache. Navigate to the following path depending on the configured web application server and delete the files.
 - Tomcat:

<Tomcat installation folder>/work/Catalina/localhost/<Application name>/org/apache/jsp

— WebLogic:

<WebLogic installation location>/domains/<Domain
name>/servers/<Server name>/tmp/_WL_user/<Application name>

— WebSphere:

<WebSphere installation directory>/AppServer/profiles/<Profile
name>/temp/<Node name>/server1/<Application name>/<.war file
name>

13. Apply the 33918437 Mandatory Patch.

See the Readme that is packaged with the patch for further instructions on how to install and apply it.

- **14.** Delete the existing EAR/WAR file available in the \$FIC HOME/ficweb directory.
- 15. Install the OFSAAIRunner package.

This is an optional step and applicable only if you have installed Oracle R Enterprise Edition (ORE).

16. Restart all the OFSAAI services.

17. Generate the application EAR/WAR file and redeploy the application onto your configured web application server.

18. Configure the document upload settings.

2 Additional Configurations

2.1 Installing the OFSAAI Runner Package with Enhancements for OFS AAI 8.0.8.6.0

NOTE

- This is a post-installation configuration and is applicable if you have installed Oracle R Enterprise (ORE) for Oracle Financial Services Enterprise Modeling (OFS EMF) Application.
- This configuration does not apply to the Tomcat web server.

If OFS Enterprise Modeling is licensed and enabled in your OFSAA instance, uninstall the OFSAAI Runner package and reinstall the latest available OFSAAI Runner package.
