Known Issues

This section describes known issues in version 6.5.2 of MDEX.

(21658022) Flexera bug - Silent installation never completes installing to read-only directory

If you perform a silent installation of the MDEX into a read-only directory, the installer is stuck in an infinite loop .

Workaround: Terminate the installation program with `Ctrl+C`. Change the permission on the target installation directory so you have write permissions for it. Then restart the silent installation.

(21696117) Non-ASCII characters are displayed incorrectly in license agreement during MDEX installation

During MDEX installation, non-ASCII characters in the license agreement are displayed incorrectly. This happens on all operating systems.

(21746398) Flexera bug - Some localized installer messages are displayed in English

Due to a defect in InstallAnywhere®, some localized installer messages are displayed in English.

Workaround: See Flexera support Case #00720876.

(21746540) Flexera bug - Uninstall does not preserve files added post-installation on NAS

Due to a defect in InstallAnywhere®, when you install MDEX in NFS-shared drive and later uninstall MDEX, it deletes all files which were added post-installation.

Workaround: See Flexera support Case #00620844.
