- Alerts triggered on monitored thresholds
- Starting and stopping NMS Services
- Sending Action commands to enable/disable debug
- Isis Snapshots
- Associated targets

### Add NMS System Alarms

The NMS System Alarms will be displayed within the **Incidents and Problems** panel on the NMS Services Home page. All incidents can be viewed and managed from the OEM Incident Manager.

### Broadcast Message to All Logged-In Users

The ability to broadcast a message to all currently logged-in NMS users. This can be useful to announce a planned time to take down an environment for a patch or upgrade or to indicate that the support team is aware of performance issues and is investigating.

### View NMS Services Log Files

The ability for an NMS AMP user to be able to view the log files for the NMS Services.

### Online Help for NMS AMP

The capability to launch Online Help for NMS AMP specific content. For the main pages, the help will be context sensitive. All other help will be found in the Network Management System Management folder under the Contents section of the OEM Online Help display.
