Provides late-breaking information and known issues for the JavaFX 2.2.7 release.

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This release of the standalone JavaFX 2.2.7 contains component updates that enable JavaFX to run with JDK 6 Update 41.

These release notes apply to JDK 6 users on Windows platforms. For these users, the JavaFX 2.2.7 SDK or Runtime can be installed as a standalone application. See *JavaFX 2.2.7 Installation Guide*.

For JDK 7 users, the JavaFX 2.2.7 SDK and Runtime libraries are installed and co-located with those for JDK/JRE 7. See *JDK 7 Update Release Notes* for information about JDK 7 installations.
