Oracle Retail Merchandising System (RMS) Release 10.1.25 is a patch release for RMS 10.1. RMS 10.1.25 includes selected defect fixes and enhancements for RMS 10.1 code.

Oracle Customer Support investigates submitted issues assuming that all released updates have been applied. It is the customer's decision when to apply a new release; however, delays in applying updates can complicate the support process.

Applying the Patch Release

Before applying the RMS 10.1.25 patch release, be sure that:

- RMS 10.1 has been installed
- Patch releases through RMS 10.1.24 have been applied

Before applying the new files:

- Note whether any modules have been customized. If so, the customizations must be reapplied to the new version of the module, or the fix may need to be applied to the custom version of the code.
- Copy the original files to a different directory before you copy over them, in case you need to refer to them at a later date.

Running Scripts

Back up data before running any script, because the scripts provided *do not* preserve data. See defect reports for details.

Check with your database administrator to determine whether your database should be analyzed after a script is run. In many cases, analysis of the database is necessary to take advantage of new or modified indexes intended to improve performance of the application.

Defect Fixes and Documentation

A defect fix is a modification to the base Oracle Retail code (for example, a bug fix, a performance enhancement, or a functional enhancement). Each defect fix that is included in this release has a corresponding defect report titled *<defect-number> <module>.PDF* (for example, 12345678 addrb.PDF).

In the same folder, the file named DEFECT MODULE XREF RMS 10.1.25.XLS lists every defect number and the modules and scripts that are included in this release. Review each defect report carefully before implementing the defect fixes. Note that scripts do not preserve data. Make sure that all data is backed up before you run any script.

Noteworthy Defect Fixes

The following defect fixes and enhancements are included in RMS 10.1.25. This is not a complete list; see the cross-reference spreadsheet and defect reports for a complete list and full details.

Defect Number	Summary
9783705	There are restart and recovery issues for the RMS batch programs OCIROQ and REQEXT.
10029034	Incorrect triggers are created by the AUDITSYS batch for field-level audits, resulting in inserts in the audit table for any updates.
12565669	When supplier lead time is modified from null to not null at the item-supplier-country level after replenishment is created for an item.
