# Release Notes

## Overview

Oracle Retail Customer Support investigates submitted issues assuming all release patches have been applied. While it is ultimately at the client's discretion as to when to apply patches, delays or lags in their application can complicate the support process.

To assist in the patch review, Oracle Retail Customer Support provides a system-level assessment by assigning a Priority. In addition, a cross-reference spreadsheet is provided to assist with this research. Please review the enclosed defect documents promptly to determine the impact to your business operations.

This patch contains general product fixes, French version-specific defect fixes, French translation terminology corrections, and functional enhancements. See the 'Defect Documentation' and 'French Release-Specific Defect Documentation' sections of this document for more details.

Before installing RMS 11.0.6 French, confirm that RMS 11.0 and all following patches up to RMS 11.0.5 French have been successfully applied. Refer to the patch documentation for detailed information on each fix.

**Note:** The RMS 11.0.6 French release is the next release after the RMS 11.0.5 French release. Retrofit modifications from the English releases of RMS 11.0.4 and RMS 11.0.5 patches are combined in this release.

As with all patches, the following points should be considered before applying the RMS 11.0.6 French patch.

- Copy the original files to an archive directory before you overwrite them in case they are later needed for reference.
- Note whether customizations have been made to the module. If so, the customizations need to be reapplied to the new version of the module (or the fix may need to be applied to the custom version of the code).

## Defect Documentation

A defect fix is a modification to the base Oracle Retail code (for example, a bug fix, performance enhancement, or functional enhancement). Each defect fix included in this patch has a corresponding defect document titled <defect#> <module>.doc (for example, "123456 nxprcno.doc"). Defect documents should be fully reviewed before this patch is implemented. Defect documents are separated into two sections: 11.0.6 English, and 11.0.6 French-specific. To assist with the patch application process, there is also a defect module cross-reference spreadsheet in the same folder as the defect fixes (DEFECT MODULE XREF RMS <version>.xls) which lists the defects and allows sorting by defect, program/module name, revision number, functional area, priority, and defect description. Defect documents for each defect and module affected are also included. See the specific defect documents for details. The cross-reference spreadsheet may be used to match up French defect numbers with their corresponding English defect numbers.

## Summary of Noteworthy Defects

### Performance Issues

- **Defect 398330**  
In ORSETUPB.PLS and ORDMTXWS.FMB, a performance issue arises when the system is creating purchase orders involving a large volume of items and locations (400 items and 40 locations).
- **Defect 4879810**  
Performance issues exist on EDIDPRD.PC, PREPOST.PC.

## French Release-Specific Defect Documentation

Language specific defects to this version of RMS are listed in the defect module cross-reference spreadsheet (DEFECT MODULE XREF RMS <version>.xls). Language-specific defects are code changes which are made specifically for the language or defects which were not included in the corresponding English release. Defect documents for each defect and module affected are also included. See the defect documents for details.

### Summary of the French Release Specific Defects

- **Defect 398496**  
The labels in the forms ORDSKU.FMB, ORDLOC.FMB, ORDSKUS.FMB use the incorrect French translated values.
- **Defect 397648**  
In ORDSKU, various fields are updated inaccurately when the system attempts to cancel order quantities or update the unit cost of items in an order. This defect was not released in RMS 11.0.6 English.
