This document corrects the Release Notes for Oracle Retail Price Management (RPM) documentation-only Release 12.0.10.1.

Documentation Release Only

Note: The Oracle Retail Price Management (RPM) 12.0.10.1.1 release is a documentation-only release. There is no code associated with this release identifier. RPM 12.0.10 remains the current version of the code.

This Release Notes document is the only component of the RPM 12.0.10.1.1 release. The purpose of this Release Notes document is only to correct the RPM 12.0.10.1 updates to the *Oracle Retail Price Management Installation Guide* for Release 12.0.10.

Notes:

- This document replaces the Oracle Retail Price Management Release Notes for Release 12.0.10.1, a documentation-only release.
 - This Release Notes document specifically corrects the release of the Java Runtime Environment (JRE) required for RPM 12.0.10, which is 5.0 Update 11 (1.5.0_11) or newer, as originally stated in the *Oracle Retail Price Management Installation Guide* for Release 12.0.10. This document also restates the other corrections to that installation guide.
