This document highlights the major changes for Oracle Retail Service Layer (RSL) Release 12.0.9.

Oracle Customer Support investigates submitted issues assuming that all released patches have been applied. It is the customer's decision when to apply a patch; however, delays in applying patches can complicate the support process.

Technical Enhancements

This release of the Oracle Retail Service Layer 12.0.9 represents a repackaging effort that includes the following changes:

- Oracle Retail Service Layer 12.0.9 is compatible with Oracle Application Server 10g (10.1.3.3).
- The files retek-payload-typed.jar and retek-rib-support.jar have been replaced. These replacements include changes to message families not used by RSL. For more details about the changes to the families, see the *Oracle Retail Integration Bus Release Notes* for Release 12.0.9.

No other changes were made to the RSL code for this release.
