Oracle Retail Price Optimization Release 12.0.12 is a patch release for Price 12.0. Price 12.0.12 includes selected defect fixes for Price 12.0 code.

Oracle Customer Support investigates submitted issues assuming that all released updates have been applied. It is the customer's decision when to apply a new release; however, delays in applying updates can complicate the support process.

Release Number

The previous release of Price code was Release 12.0.7. To align the release numbers for the Oracle Retail products, this release of Oracle Retail Price Optimization is named Release 12.0.12.

About Patch Releases

Oracle Retail patch releases are periodic releases that can include the following:

- New defect fixes
- Product enhancements
- Technology Upgrades
- Performance fixes

Documentation for patch releases includes new and updated guides (for example, Operations Guides, and User Guides, and so on) that apply to the patch release level. These documents include applicable updates made since the last patch release. Documents revised for this patch release supersede and replace all previous document versions.

Note: Customers must apply the entire patch release to update their installation to the currently supported level.

- Note whether any modules have been customized. If so, the customizations must be reapplied to the new version of the module, or the fix may need to be applied to the custom version of the code.
- Copy the original files to a different directory before you copy over them, in case you need to refer to them at a later date.

Microsoft Internet Explorer Certification

Oracle Retail Price Optimization is now also supported on Microsoft Internet Explorer 8 running on Microsoft Windows XP.

Oracle Java Runtime Environment 6

Oracle Retail Price Optimization Release 12.0.12 is supported for use with Oracle Java Runtime Environment 6 on the client and server side.

Oracle Application Server 10.1.3.5

Oracle Retail Price Optimization Release 12.0.12 is supported for use with Oracle Application Server 10.1.3.5.

Defect Fixes and Documentation

A defect fix is a modification to the base Oracle Retail code (for example, a bug fix, a performance enhancement, or a functional enhancement). Each defect fix that is included in this patch has a corresponding Defect document in the doc folder titled <Defect#>.doc, such as "123456.doc".

In the same folder, the file named DEFECT MODULE XREF PRICE 12.0.12.XLS lists every defect number and the modules and scripts that are included in the patch. Review each defect report carefully before this patch is implemented. Please note that

scripts do not preserve data. Make sure that all data is backed up before you run any script.

Noteworthy Defect Fixes

The following noteworthy defects have been fixed in this release:

Defect	Description
8511869	Weekly load fails as auto and manual collection process allows single style to belong to 2 different pricing groups.
9779623	Displays a custom message to users when system is not available.
13948510	Adding a new location cluster does not get a price group created for existing chain level price.
