## Overview

In addition to the bug fixes in this patch release, Price 12.0.7 is now certified to work with the following software:

- Database: Oracle 10g Database Release 2 (10.2.0.4)
- Client: Windows XP SP3 with Internet Explorer 7.0

This is in addition to any existing supported configurations.

## Noteworthy Fixes in This Release

The following bugs have been fixed in this release.

**10991** – The Take Markdown Advanced drop-down list now includes the current year and the next year. If, in the future, more years must be displayed in the list, they can be defined in the p4p\_params table via the NoOfYears parameter.

**11170** – The P4P\_SAME\_OR\_NULL function now recognizes nulls.

**11224** – LoadWarehouseAllocation now throws proper error messages for values not within the required range 0-1.

**11255** – The delete sql in LoadCollectionsSendback process is tuned for performance so that the process completes successfully without failing.

**11492** – When a pricing group in the Maintaining Merchandise screen is deleted, the confirmation pop up message is changed to 'Do you wish to delete this pricing group?' and is now translated to the appropriate language.

**11679** – The Report Subject line now says 'Oracle Retail Price Optimization report complete.'

**13836** – The report alert subject line is now translated into all supported languages.

## Known Issues

The following are known issues in this release.

**10788** – The copyright date in the Online Help says 2006, 2007. It should say copyright © 2005, 2009 Oracle. All rights reserved.

**14005** – Setting up the Initialization Parameters for Oracle 10g (the Installation Guide for 12.0.7 provides the details for Oracle 9):

Set up the init.ora file in the <ORACLE\_HOME>/dbs directory, specifying the following parameters:
