These release notes describe new features and enhancements as well as any specific installation and implementation considerations for Oracle Content Integration Suite (CIS) version 10g Release 3 (10.1.3.3.3).

Note: This release does not support the Content Server FileStoreProvider component if Optimized File Transfer is enabled.

1 What's New

CIS includes the following new features and enhancements compared to earlier 10gR3 releases:

Compared to CIS 10gR3 (10.1.3.3.2)

- This version of CIS deprecates the client-server architecture.

Compared to Earlier CIS 10gR3 Releases (10.1.3.3.0 and 10.1.3.3.1)

- This version of CIS offers a localized CIS Administration Application interface and localized error messages. The following languages are supported: English, German, French, Spanish, Portuguese (Brazil), Italian, Dutch, Chinese (both traditional and simplified), Japanese, and Korean. Please note that the software help is in English, regardless of the selected interface language.

2 Installation Considerations

CIS enables communication with Oracle Content Server and is deployable on a number of J2EE application servers, in addition to working in non-J2EE environments. A supported version of Oracle Content Server is required:

- Oracle Content Server 7.5.2 or later. Version 10gR3 is recommended.

3 Implementation Considerations

The following implementation considerations should be taken into account when using this version of CIS:

Administration Interface and Error Message Language

The CIS Administration Application interface language and the error message language is automatically set, depending on the locale of the operating system of

the client computer. For example, if you are running a German version of Microsoft Windows, then the CIS software will have a German interface.

Software Help System in English

The software help system of CIS is always in English, regardless of the interface language.

4 Documentation

CIS comes with a comprehensive online Help system and a full set of PDF documentation. The Help system can be accessed from the CIS Administration Application. The PDF documentation is located in the /docs directory of the unbundled CIS distribution file.

CIS Developer Guide

The CIS Developer Guide contains information on command invocation and execution, and on extending commands.

CIS Administration Guide

The CIS Administration Guide contains information on the configuration of Content Integration Suite using the CIS Administration Application.

5 Documentation Accessibility
