## **IMPORTANT INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS**

#### Java Environment

This release may require an update to your Java environment. The J2SE 1.4 SDK is now required. The latest patch release is recommended.



**Important:** JRE 1.3 is no longer supported.

### **New Features and Changes**

SSPU 10gR3 has no new features compared to version 7.5.x. It has the following new features compared to version 7.2:

- ❖ **Database compaction**—This allows the server to shrink the tables in the database that are used to track package updates (removes older redundant information from the database).
- ❖ **Database driver upgrade** for Oracle (versions 9*i* and 10*g* are supported).
- **Subscription Client** can now be run as a service.

### **RESOLVED ISSUES**

The following issues have been resolved in this release (compared to version 7.5.1):

- ❖ URLs using the '?' escape character are now handled correctly.
- Link to Native documents are now handled correctly.
- SsLink or SsNodeLINK links, which redirect to a different site in the same server, are now handled correctly.

## **KNOWN ISSUES**

## Syndicator Reports Error in Parsing Malformed Package ID (p51021316)

**Description:** The following error is included in the logs: "ERROR: delivery.ice: A confirmation was received for a different database. Confirmation will be ignored." This only occurs the first time the server has been run with a new database.

**Solution:** A restart of the server is required to synchronize the database IDs. If the server is not restarted, the delivery confirmations may not be processed correctly.
