## Overview

Oracle Retail Back Office (BO) provides a means of accessing, maintaining, and monitoring store business. The general BO user can be a store manager, assistant manager, or system administrator. Occasionally, store employees may have access to time maintenance functions. From one central server, you can access and manage employee status and roles, items, pricing, and store transactions. You can also perform basic store operations such as opening and reconciling tills, adding items, and applying price promotions.

## Functional Enhancements

As part of functional enhancements, the BO 12.0.9IN release has changes in the following screens of the application:

- Price Change Detail Screen
- Price Promotion Detail Screen
- Item Maintenance Screen
- Discount Rule Detail Screen

### Price Change Detail Screen

The "Price Change Detail" screen of the Back Office application has additions to depict the changes to the Maximum Retail Price (MRP) functionality.

The "Price Change Type", and the "Amount" are the two new fields that are added to the "Price Change Detail" screen. The "Price Change Type" is a list with pre-defined values like 'Percent off on MRP', 'Amount off on MRP', and 'New Price'. The "Amount" field takes a numerical value on the basis of which the price change is made. The new selling price is non-editable and the value is calculated based on the values in the "Price Change Type" and the "Amount" columns.

A new column called "MRP" has been added. This column depicts the primary MRP of an item, if the parameter "Retail less than MRP" is enabled.

For items having more than one MRP, the value in this column is hyperlinked.

### **Price Promotion Detail Screen**

A new column called "MRP" has been added to the "Price Promotion Detail" screen of the application. The primary MRP is displayed in this column for those items which have "Retail less than MRP" indicator set to true. For multiple MRP items, the value in this column is hyperlinked. If the user clicks the MRP hyper link, the regular price, and the promotional prices are displayed.

Another new field is introduced in the "Price Promotion Detail" screen called "Apply Promotion On". Here the user can select whether the promotion is to be applied on the MRP or on the Regular Price.

### **Item Maintenance Screen**

The "MRP" column in the "Item Maintenance" screen of the application is hyperlinked. If the item has multiple maximum retail prices, a new window with all the active MRPs for that item-store combination are displayed.

### **Discount Rule Detail Screen**

The "MRP" column in the "Discount Rule Detail" screen displays the primary MRP of the item.

### **Functionality Restricted or Removed**

The following features are restricted or removed for this release:

- Item creation functionality is disabled.
- In the installer en\_US, en\_GB, en\_CA locales are removed. Once installed for India Locale, the application cannot be switched back to any other locale.
- Seed Data is not updated for India Locale.

### **Integration Enhancement**

Two item attributes related to multiple MRP - "Retail less than MRP" and "Multiple MRP" flows to BO from Oracle Retail Merchandising System (RMS) as part of item import.

For a newly created item, the item MRP and the corresponding selling price flows to BO as "Primary MRP" from RMS as part of item import.

In addition, any price events related to multiple MRPs flows from Oracle Retail Price Management (RPM) to BO. These price events include MRP change or a new MRP addition, a change in primary MRP, an inactivation or reactivation of a MRP, a permanent price change, and simple and complex promotions.
