Release 13.0.2

This document highlights the major changes for Oracle Retail Price Management (RPM) Release 13.0.2. RPM 13.0.2 includes numerous defect fixes.

Oracle Customer Support investigates submitted issues assuming that all released patches have been applied. It is the customer's decision when to apply a patch; however, delays in applying patches can complicate the support process.

Applying Source Code

Before applying the RPM 13.0.2 patch release, be sure that RPM 13.0.1 (patch or full product version) has been installed.

Before applying the patch source files over your code:

- Note whether any modules have been customized. If so, the customizations must be reapplied to the new version of the module, or the fix may need to be applied to the custom version of the code.
- Copy the original files to a different directory before you copy over them, in case you need to refer to them at a later date.

Running Scripts

Back up data before running any script, because the scripts provided *do not* preserve data. See defect reports for details.

Check with your database administrator to determine whether your database should be analyzed after a script is run. In many cases, analysis of the database is necessary to take advantage of new or modified indexes intended to improve performance of the application.

Defect Fixes and Documentation

A defect fix is a modification to the base Oracle Retail code (for example, a bug fix, a performance enhancement, or a functional enhancement). Each defect fix that is included in this patch has a corresponding defect report titled *<defect-number>.PDF* (for example, 1234567.PDF).

In the same folder, the file named DEFECT MODULE XREF RPM 13.0.2.XLS lists every defect number and the modules and scripts that are included in the patch. Review each defect report carefully before this patch is implemented. Please note that scripts do not preserve data. Make sure that all data is backed up before you run any script.

Noteworthy Defect Fixes

The following defect fixes and enhancements are included in RPM 13.0.2. This is not a complete list; see the cross-reference spreadsheet and defect reports for a complete list and full details.

Defect Number	Summary
7259043	In the Price Change screen, the Basis Unit Retail column is always blank.
7416433	When the batch program MerchExtractKickOffBatch is run, an error occurs: "ORA-12899: value too large for column."
7460590	The Apply Subclass Defaults functionality of the Create Clearance workflow is not working as intended. When Apply Subclass Defaults is selected (checked), a markdown record should be created if the department has a Clearance Defaults strategy defined.
7475119	In the Worksheet Detail screen, when the promotion column hyperlink "yes" is clicked, an error occurs.
