Technical Enhancements

The following is a technical enhancement for Oracle Retail Merchandising System.

Oracle Internet Directory 11g Release 1

Oracle Retail Merchandising System Release 13.2.3 is supported for use with Oracle Internet Directory (OID) 11gR1 (11.1.1.5).

If you have localized RMS for Brazilian operations by installing the Oracle Retail Fiscal Management (ORFM) module, ORFM 13.2.3 is also supported for use with Oracle Internet Directory 11gR1.

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
