Foundation Data

This chapter describes the changes to the forms in the Foundation Data module of the Oracle Retail Merchandising System (RMS). The Organizational Hierarchy, Supplier and Partner Management, and Outside Locations functionalities have been changed to add new fiscal attributes. New localization system option parameters are also added.

Organizational Hierarchy

The organizational hierarchy enables you to create the relationships that are necessary to support the operational structure of a company. You can create a preferred organizational structure to support consolidated reporting at various levels of the company. Also, you can assign responsibility for any level of the hierarchy to a person or persons in order to satisfy internal reporting requirements.

Company Maintenance

This section describes the updates in the Company Maintenance window to meet the Brazil market requirements.

To view the changes for the Company menu, do the following:

Navigate: From the **RMS Start Menu**, select **Action**, then select **Organizational Hierarchy**, or **Action**, then select **Merchandise Hierarchy**. The Organization Hierarchy Main Form or the Merchandise Hierarchy Main Form is displayed.

1. On the tree structure, select **Company**.
2. Click **Edit** or **View**. The Company Maintenance window appears.

Note: In View mode, the fields are disabled. This is applicable across all windows in RMS.

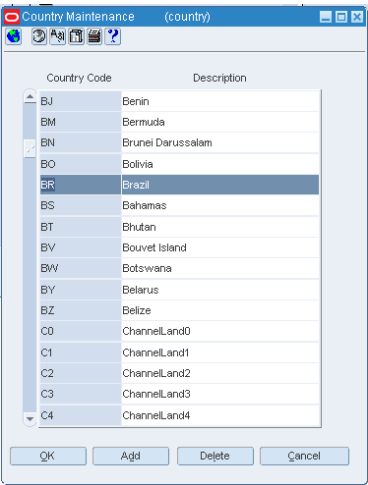

In the Contents Of Country window, select **View** or **Edit**. The Country Maintenance window appears.

Figure 1–2 Country Maintenance Window

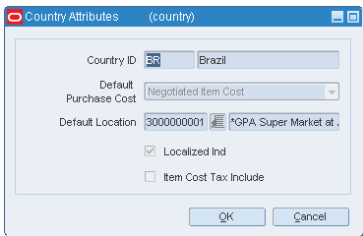


Setting Attributes for the Country

To set up attributes for a country, do the following:

1. In the Country Maintenance window, set the Country Code as BR. From the **Options** menu, select **Attributes**. The Country Attributes window opens.

2. For Brazil, the Default Purchase Cost LOV displays Negotiated Item Cost (NIC), and Base Cost (BC). This field defines the cost that has to be used to raise a PO.
3. A new check box, **Localized Ind** is introduced to indicate whether the Brazil patch is installed. If the Brazil patch is installed, this check box is automatically selected.
4. Select the **Item Cost Tax Include** check box to indicate that the item cost entered is inclusive of taxes (NIC) or exclusive of taxes (BC).

Fiscal Attributes

Note: In RMS, you can set the fiscal attributes for the country only once per installation.

To view and set the updates in the Localization Flexible Attributes form, do the following:

1. In the Country Maintenance window, select a country. From the **Options** menu, select **Fiscal Attributes**. The Localization Flexible Attributes window appears.

Country Tax Jurisdiction

RMS has a new Country Tax Jurisdiction form that enables you to set up tax jurisdictions. It captures the country code, tax/legal jurisdiction code and a description. In Brazil tax rates vary from city to city. The Country Jurisdiction window helps in specifying the tax/legal jurisdiction code, and description. The taxes that are applicable to any location is decided based on the jurisdiction code, and the description provided in the Country Tax Jurisdiction form.

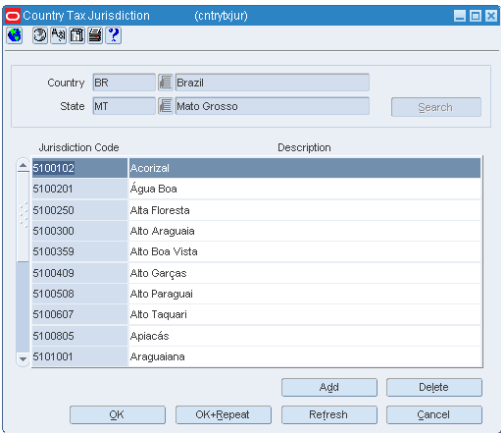
Viewing the Country Tax Jurisdiction

To view the jurisdiction code for the country, do the following:

Navigate: From the **RMS Start Menu**, select **Control**, then select **Setup**. From **Setup**, select **Country Tax Jurisdiction**.

1. In the Contents of Country Tax Jurisdiction, click **View**. The Country Tax Jurisdiction window appears.
2. In the Country Jurisdiction window, select the **Country** and **State** from the LOV. Click **Search**.

3. Click **OK** to exit the Country Tax Jurisdiction window.

Adding a Jurisdiction Code

To add a jurisdiction code, do the following:

Navigate: From the **RMS Start Menu**, select **Control**, then select **Setup**. From **Setup**, select **Country Tax Jurisdiction**.

1. In the Contents Of Country Tax Jurisdiction, click **Edit**. The Country Tax Jurisdiction window appears.
2. In the Country Jurisdiction window, select the **Country** and **State** from the LOV.
3. Click **Add**. A highlighted blank row is displayed. Enter the **Jurisdiction Code** and **Description** for the selected country and state.
4. Click **OK** to exit the window.

Deleting a Jurisdiction Code

Note: The application does not allow you to delete a jurisdiction code if it is associated with any entity.

To delete a jurisdiction code, do the following:

Navigate: From the **RMS Start Menu**, select **Control**, then select **Setup**. From **Setup**, select **Country Tax Jurisdiction**.

1. In the Contents of Country Tax Jurisdiction, click **Edit**. The Country Tax Jurisdiction window appears.
2. In the Country Jurisdiction window, select the **Country** and **State** from the LOV.
3. Select the record, and click **Delete**. A confirmation message appears.
4. Click **Yes**. The selected **Jurisdiction Code** and **Description** are deleted.
5. Click **OK** to exit from the window.

Store Maintenance

This section describes the updates in the Store Maintenance window to meet the Brazil market requirements.

To view/edit the changes made to the Store Maintenance window, do the following:

Navigate: From the **RMS Start Menu**, select **Action**, then select **Organizational Hierarchy**. The Organization Hierarchy Main Window is displayed.

Fiscal Attributes

A new option called **Fiscal Attributes** has been introduced in the **Options** menu of the Store Maintenance window. The fiscal attributes window captures the fiscal attributes such as address, and other attributes such as CNPJ/CPF number.

In the Store Maintenance window, from the **Options** menu, select **Fiscal Attributes**. The Localization Flexible Attributes window appears.

Editing/Viewing Fiscal Attributes

To edit/view the fiscal attributes of the store, do the following;

1. In the Localization Flexible Attributes window, click **Store Fiscal Address** to edit/view the primary address of the selected store.

Note: In View mode, the fields are disabled.

2. Set the Taxpayer Type to be Corporate Taxpayer. The other option available is Individual Taxpayer.

Enter the Jurisdiction code in the City field.

Click **Apply** to save the changes.

3. Click **Store Registration Numbers** to edit/view the following attributes of the store:
 - CPF – The federal taxpayer number issued by the Brazilian Government to a person. CPF is the short form for Cadastro de Pessoa Física.
 - CNPJ – Federal taxpayer number issued by the Brazilian Government to a company. CNPJ is the short form for Cadastro Nacional de Pessoas Jurídicas.
 - NIT – The worker identification number, also known as PIS number is used for the partner master data if the partner is an individual taxpayer and it is ISS contributor.
 - SUFRAMA – Registration code for the government organ (called SUFRAMA) responsible for the free zone of Manaus
 - City Inscription – Registration number assigned by a City Municipal Authority
 - State Inscription – Registration number assigned by the State

4. Click **Store Fiscal Classifications**. The following check boxes appear:
- **ISS Contributor** – Select this check box if the store is a contributor of the Imposto sobre Serviço (ISS). This is the city tax for services sales.
 - **Rural Producer** – Select this check box if the store is a rural producer.
 - **IPI Contributor** – Select this check box if the store is a contributor of the Imposto sobre Produtos Industrializados (IPI). This is the federal tax.
 - **ICMS Contributor** – Select this check box if the store is a contributor of the Imposto sobre Circulação de Mercadorias e prestação de Serviços (ICMS). ICMS is a state tax.
 - **PIS Contributor** – Select this check box if the store is a contributor of the Programa de Integração Social (PIS). This is also a federal tax.
 - **COFINS Contributor** – Select this check box if the store is a contributor of the Contribuição para Financiamento da Seguridade Social (COFINS).

 - The Matching Operation Type list is displayed. In Edit mode, two options are displayed: Centralized or De-centralized.
 - Select the **Control Recovery of ST** check box to indicate that the store has control on the recovery of ICMS-ST. ST is the short form of Substituição Tributária.

Tributary Substitution

The Tributary Substitution is the regime in which the responsibility for the tax payment is attributed to a single taxpayer in the commercial chain. This taxpayer is called the Substitute. The taxpayer at the receiving side of the operation with the tax already collected is called Substituted.

For inter-state operations, the rule for tax collection and application follows the legislation of the destination state.

Note: The Tributary Substitution feature has been introduced in Warehouse, Supplier, Partners and Outside Locations.

Adding a Tributary Substitution for the store

In the Localization Flexible Attributes of the Store, from the **Options** menu, select **Tributary Substitution**. The Tributary Substitution window appears.

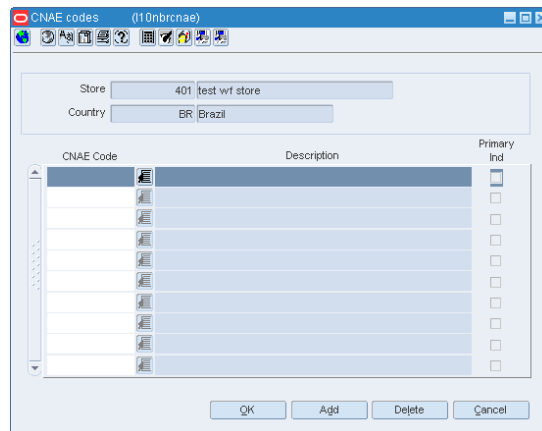

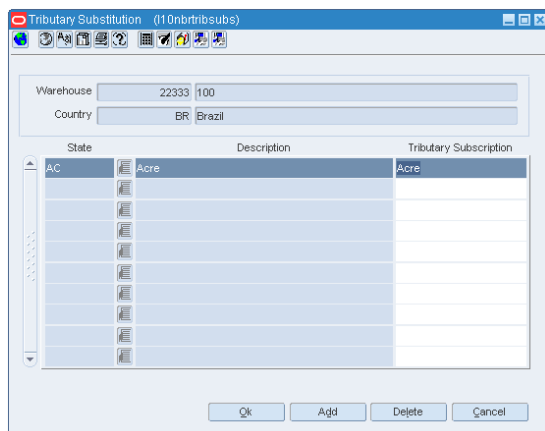

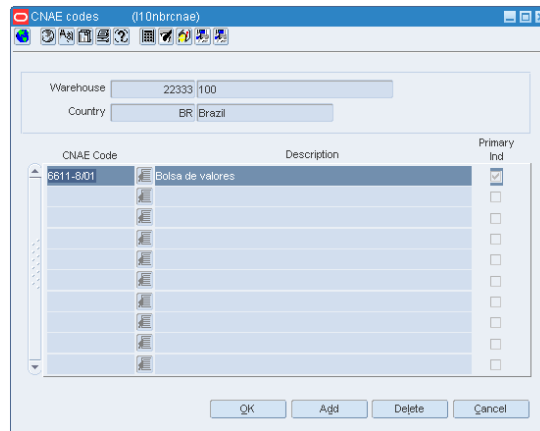

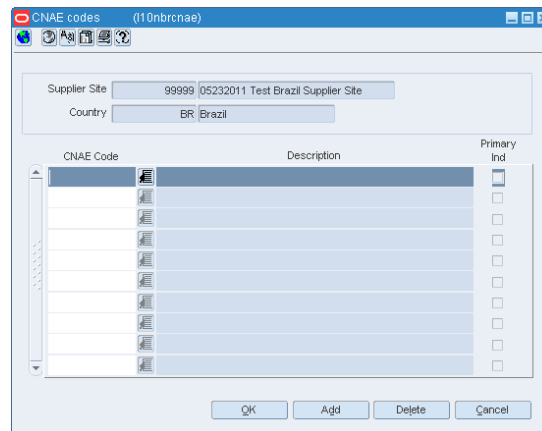

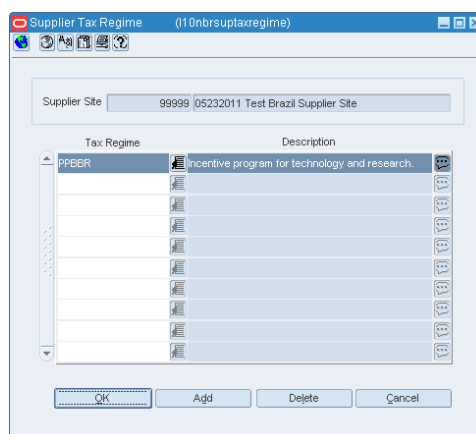

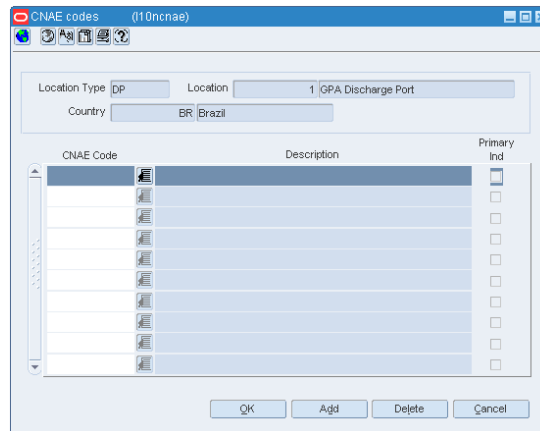
Figure 1–45 Outside Location Fiscal Classifications

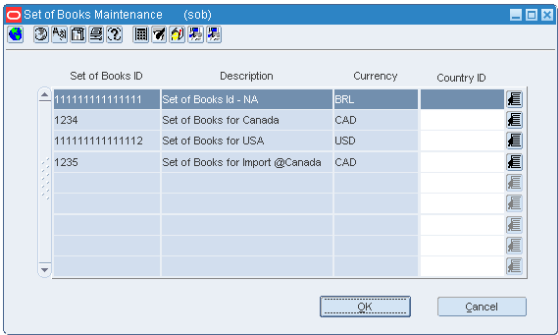

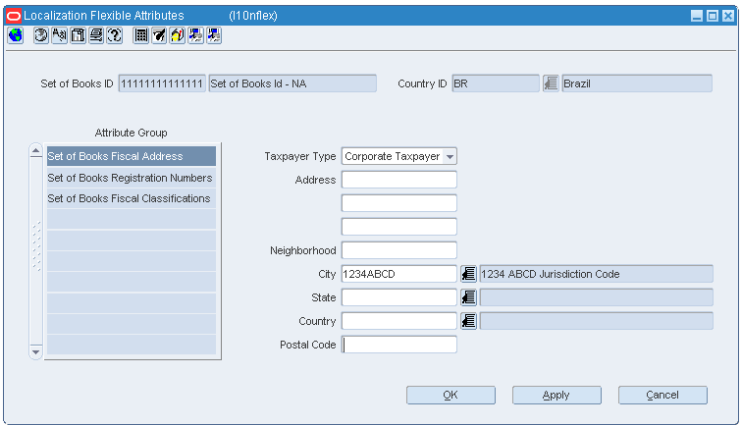

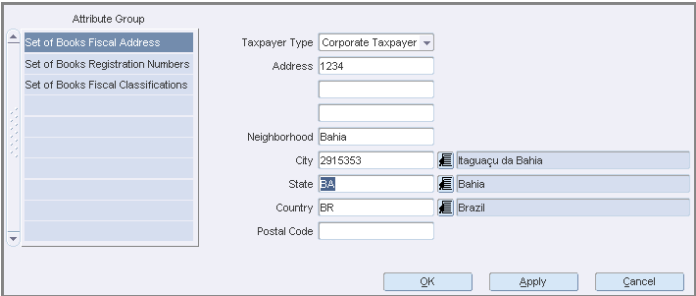
Figure 1–48 Localization Flexible Attributes Window

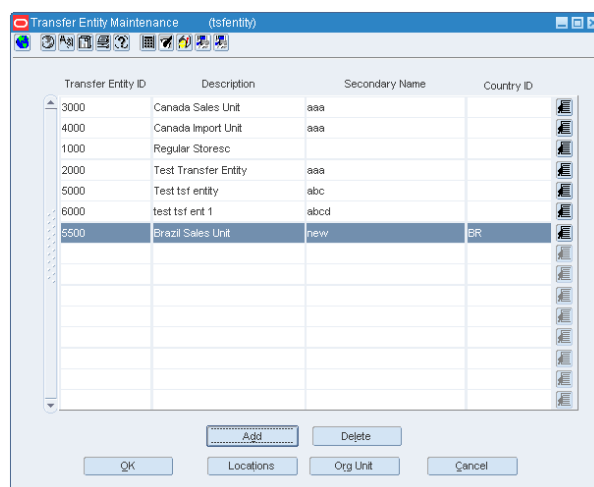

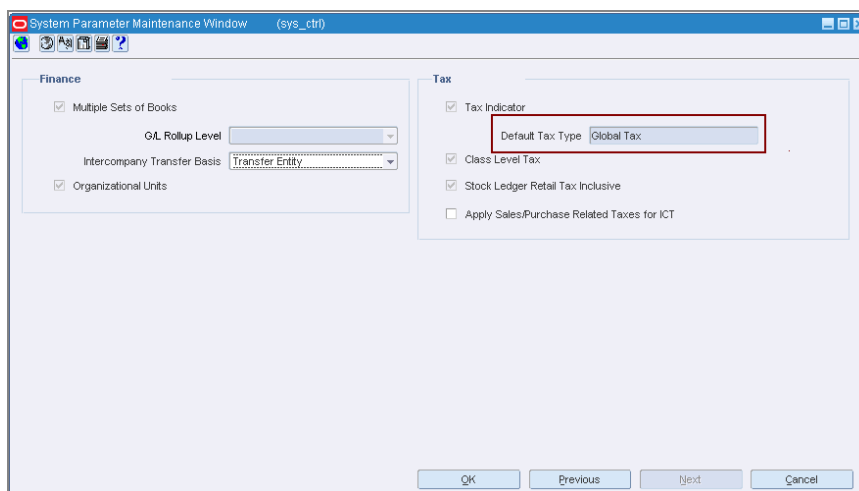

Fiscal Classification Codes

In Brazil, every item has a fiscal classification code called as Nomenclatura Comum do Mercosul or NCM. NCM codes, in general, are a classification of merchandise issued by the Brazilian government and are used to determine the taxes applicable to an item. As NCM codes are applicable to all the Mercosul countries, the new Fiscal Classification window provides the option to capture the country code along with the NCM codes.

Editing/Viewing the Fiscal Classification

To edit/view the fiscal classification, do the following:

Navigate: From the **RMS Start Menu**, select **Items**, then **Fiscal Classification**.

1. In the Contents Of Fiscal Classification window, select **Edit** or **View**. The Fiscal Classification window appears.

Note: In View mode, the fields are disabled.

Consume NCM Codes from TaxWeb Tax Rules

After RMS is integrated with TaxWeb Tax Rules, TaxWeb Tax Rules has to manage the NCM codes. The following changes have been made in RMS to use the NCM codes that are provided by TaxWeb Tax Rules:

- A new integration mechanism has been provided to consume the NCM codes from TaxWeb Tax Rules.
- New tables are introduced to store the NCM details.
- TaxWeb Tax Rules provides the necessary updates to NCM codes. TaxWeb Tax Rules manages adding, deleting, and updating the NCM codes.

Fiscal Reclassification

After an item is approved, you cannot change the fiscal classification of the item. This is because a change in NCM code triggers recalculation of taxes.

If you have to change the fiscal classification, a new fiscal reclassification window has been added. After you capture the reclassification details, the reclassification of NCM code happens on the active date during the nightly batch run.

The fiscal reclassification is possible only for those approved regular items that has item levels less than or equal to the transaction level.

If an item (Level 1) with child items is selected, the fiscal reclassification is applied for all item levels. A warning message is displayed to determine whether you want to continue with the reclassification.

Editing a Fiscal Classification

To edit the fiscal classification, do the following:

Navigate: From the **RMS Start Menu**, select **Items**, then **ReClassification**.

In the Contents Of Reclassification window, select **Fiscal Reclassification**.

In the Contents Of Fiscal Reclassification window, select **New**. The Fiscal Reclassification window appears.

1. From the LOV, select the item for which you want to change the fiscal classification.

Note: In case the item you have selected is a level 1 item, the application displays the following message:

Item x is a Level 1 item. The reclassification will be applied to all the items. Do you want to continue?

Click **Yes** to continue. Else, click **No**.

For the selected item, the country, and the old NCM code are displayed.

In addition, the Fiscal Reclassification window displays the following characteristics associated with the old NCM:

- EX IPI Code – This is the exception code defined by the Brazilian Government.
- PAUTA Code – This is the lowest level code for tax classification. This code represents the item, and is used to calculate the "pauta", which means a pre-defined base of calculation for ICMS-ST controlled at item level by the Government.
- MTR Service Code – Unified service code from TaxWeb Tax Rules system.

- Federal Service Code – Service code provided by Federal Government of Brazil (based on the regulation number 116 from July 31st, 2003).
 - State of Manufacturer – Indicates the state in which the product is manufactured, as the benefits for items varies depending on the state.
 - Pharmaceuticals List – Three different lists of medicines can be associated to the product and determines the tax calculation behavior. The list contains the following three values:
 - Negative – The product is associated with the negative list.
 - Positive – The product is associated with the positive list.
 - Neutral – The product is associated with the neutral list.
 - NULL – The product is not associated with any list.
2. Select the **New Merchandise Origin** from the list. The following options are available:
 - National
 - Service
 - Foreign Item bought from Brazil vendor
 3. Select the **New Service Ind** check box to indicate that the item is a service item.
 4. Assign the **New NCM Code** from the LOV.

The EX IPI Code, PAUTA Code, MTR Service Code, and the Federal Service Code associated with the new NCM are also displayed.

Note: The NCM Characteristic, EX IPI and Pauta codes associated to the NCM is defaulted upon entering the new NCM, given that only one NCM Characteristic, EX IPI and Pauta code is associated to the given NCM. If there are multiple characteristics associated to the NCM, no value is defaulted.

5. Set an active date in **Active Date** field. The reclassification of NCM code happens based on the active date set here during the nightly batch run.
6. Click **OK** to save the changes and exit the window.
7. Click **OK+Repeat** to change the fiscal classification for another approved item.

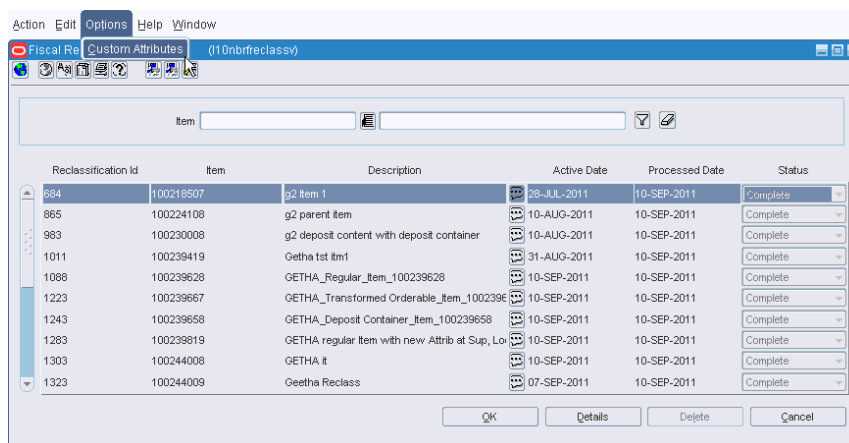

Tax Changes

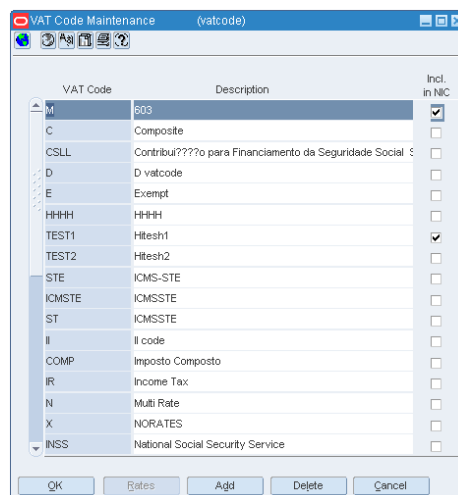

Tax Regions

The department level VAT maintenance is not used in Brazil because the retail taxes in Brazil are applied according to the NCM code (item level). A tax code can have more than one rate, based on the NCM code and the state or city where the item is transacted.

Item Maintenance

In order to meet certain requirements in Brazil, changes have been made at the item master level. This chapter describes the updates to the forms in the Item Maintenance module.

A new form Item Country window is added to the Item Maintenance form. The Item Supplier Country of Sourcing window has been modified.

Item Country Window

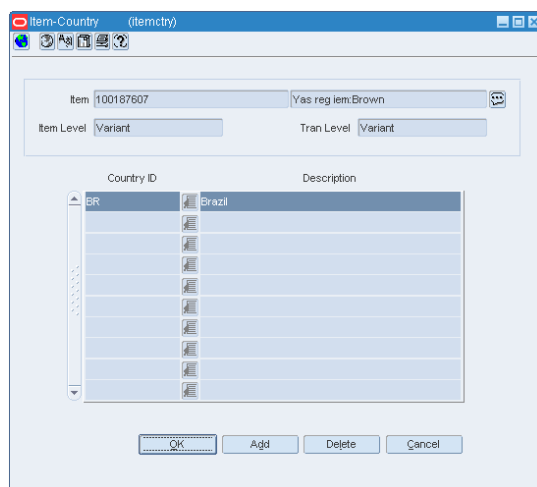
Figure 3–1 Item Maintenance Window

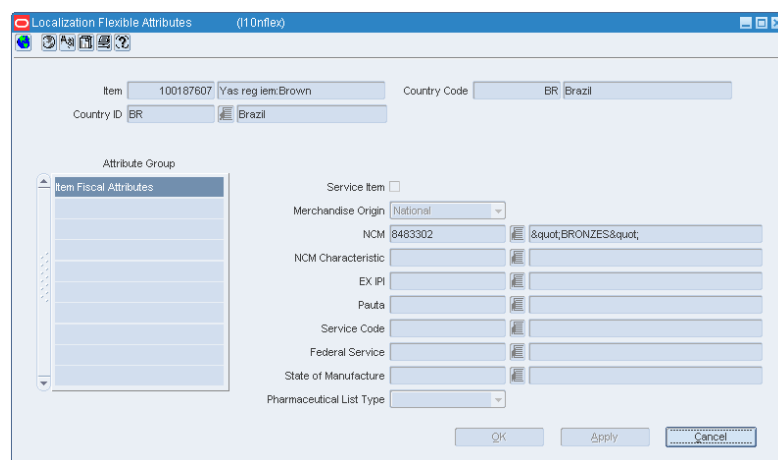

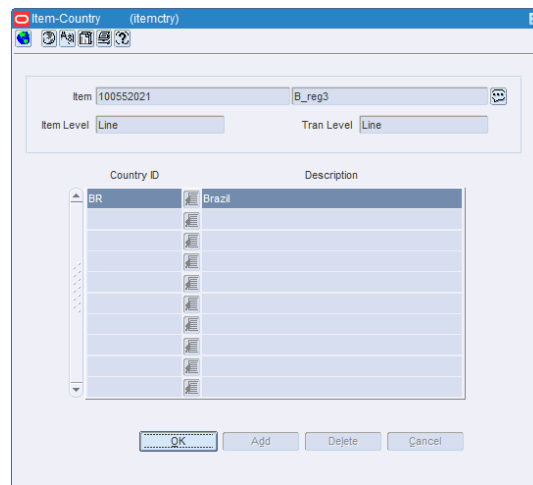

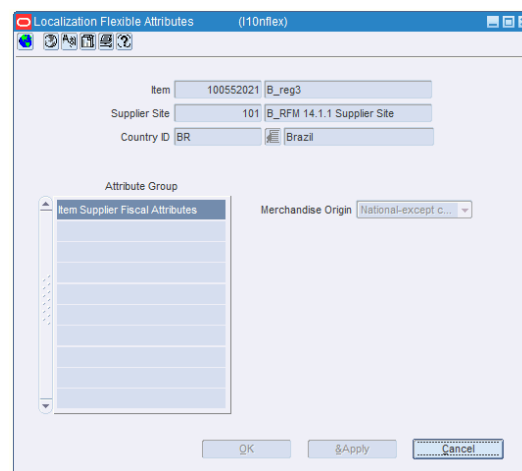

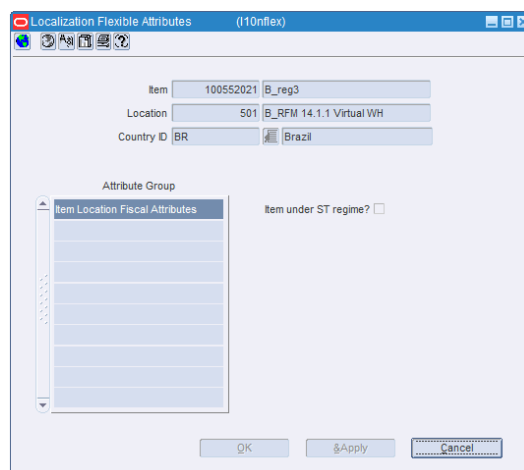

6. In the Filter section of the Item Costing window, some fields are non-editable and the values are defaulted from the previous window. The fields are as follows:

- Item – This field displays the item code set from the previous form/window.
- Supplier Site – This field displays the supplier site.
- Country of Sourcing – This field displays the country of sourcing.

7. In the Delivery Country field, enter the country to which the item will be shipped to. The LOV displays only the countries associated with the item.

8. The Default Location is a non-editable field and is based on the delivery country selected.

9. Select the **Primary Delivery Country** check box for the designated primary delivery country.

This defines multiple delivery countries for one supplier and country of sourcing combination. However, only one delivery country can be a primary delivery country.

10. Select the **Item Costing Inclusive of Tax** check box based on the delivery country. This is a non-editable field, and the check box is selected, if for the delivery country, the cost is inclusive of the tax.

11. Enter the **Input Cost**. Enter cost inclusive of taxes (NIC) or cost exclusive of taxes (BC).

If the delivery country considers the item costing to be inclusive of tax, the input cost is interpreted as NIC, else it is interpreted as BC.

12. The **Currency** field is non-editable field. This field displays the currency based on the currency set for the delivery country.

13. Select the **NIC is Static** check box, in case you want to retain the same NIC for all locations ranged for the supplier and item combination.

RMS makes a call to TaxWeb Tax Rules by passing this NIC and location attributes. Based on the taxes fetched by TaxWeb Tax Rules, RMS calculates the other costs. You can override the NIC at a location level. In case you do not select this check box, for all locations ranged, the BC will remain the same. RMS makes a call to

TaxWeb Tax Rules by passing this BC and location attributes. Based on the taxes fetched by TaxWeb Tax Rules, RMS calculates the other costs.

Utilization Code

In Brazil, every transaction type such as the purchase order, transfer, and return to vendor (RTV) has the information about the purpose of buying/selling/transfer. This is referred to as Fiscal Utilization. The fiscal utilization determines the appropriate taxes for the retail operation, the impact on stocks and costs, and the type of information to be sent to other systems.

About Triangulation Purchase

In Brazil, when creating a purchase order, you can set the supplier (referred to as the main supplier) to whom the payment will be made and another supplier (a distributor or facilitator) who will deliver the merchandise on behalf of the main supplier (referred to as the delivery supplier). This mechanism is referred to as the triangulation purchase.

The order is placed on a primary supplier who co-ordinates merchandise delivery from its trading partners. This helps the retailer with the hassles of negotiating with multiple suppliers. It can also be used where the supplier engages supply chain partners, such as clearing and forwarding agents/consolidators to deliver merchandise to the final destination.

For triangulation, one Nota Fiscal is sent by the supplier for whom the order is raised. Another complimentary Nota Fiscal is sent by the delivery supplier to charge any additional expenses (such as a change in tax rate/transportation expenses) incurred during the shipping of merchandise.

A call is made to TaxWeb Tax Rules. Relevant transaction details such as PO number, PO date, supplier, store/warehouse, item code, cost, utilization code, quantity and necessary calculations for tax are sent. TaxWeb Tax Rules sends the tax back to RMS. The calculation of tax happens on an on-demand basis.

If the tax calculation is not done before PO approval, it takes place during the PO approval. For externally or automatically generated orders, the tax calculation during approval is automatic and not on demand.

For items that are eligible for a change in the taxable basis, the tax rate is applied on the modified taxable basis. The Modified Taxable Basis column depicts the basis at which the tax is applied.

Viewing Tax Details at Item-Location

To view the tax details at the item/location level, a new Tax Breakup button has been added on the PO Item/Location window.

Landed Cost

Landed Cost is the total cost of an item received from a vendor, inclusive of the supplier cost and all costs associated with moving the item from the supplier's warehouse or factory to the final destination (warehouse or store).

Estimated Landed Cost

Estimated Landed Cost (ELC) is the bottom-up cost estimate created by the buying organization. ELC is composed of cost components from the supplier, trading partners, item, country of sourcing/manufacturing, and banks that are brought together during the PO creation to develop an estimate of costs associated with purchasing a particular item on the current PO.

Cost Components

Cost components are combinations of individual expenses, assessments and the calculations associated with that expense or assessment.

Define an Expense

The Cost Component Maintenance window has been updated to include the expenses in Brazil.

To view the new expenses, do the following:

Navigate: From the **RMS Start Menu**, select **Control**, then select **Landed Cost**.

About Two-Legged Transfers

A retailer may send merchandise to the external finisher or the supplier for finishing work (such as printing, dyeing, and embroidery), or repair (in case of damaged merchandise). After the finishing or repairing work is done, the finisher or the supplier may return the merchandise back to the same location or to a different location. The merchandise may be sent to a third party warehouse merely for temporary stocking and as required, the third party warehouse may send them back. While the merchandise are out of warehouse or store for stocking, repair, or finishing, RMS accounts for the inventory as the retailer's inventory.

This flow is handled in RMS through two-legged transfers. In the first leg, inventory is sent from the retailer's location (warehouse or store) to the finisher's location. In the second leg, finished or repaired merchandise are received back from the finisher at the retailer's location. Because the finisher's location is an outside location, the retailer is not responsible for the receiving or shipping activities at those locations.

Creating two-legged transfers

Repairing activity can be initiated from any downstream application. The details of the activity are published to RMS to create a two-legged transfer. The following changes have been made in RMS to create a two-legged transfer:

1. The downstream application has to publish the transfer details for the first leg such as the warehouse/store-external finisher.
2. RMS checks the "To location" on the transfer. If the "To location" is an external finisher, it creates a two-legged transfer using the "from" and "to" locations. The first leg will have the "From location" and "To location". This location information is published by the downstream applications, and the second leg will have the "To location" as "From Location" and "From Location" as "To Location."

Transfer Utilization Code

In Brazil, every transaction types such as purchase order, transfer, return to vendor will have the information about the purpose of buying or selling or transfer. This is typically referred to as Utilization. Each utilization code is associated with one or more CFOP codes. CFOP codes are provided by the Federal government which is used to do the tax calculation in ORFM.

Adding Utilization Code

To add an utilization code, do the following:

Navigate: From the **RMS Start Menu**, select **Inventory**, then select **Transfer**. The Transfer Search window appears.

1. Search for, and retrieve a transfer in **New/Edit** mode. The Transfer Maintenance window appears.
2. Click the **Options** menu. Utilization is part of the Options menu in the Transfer Maintenance window.

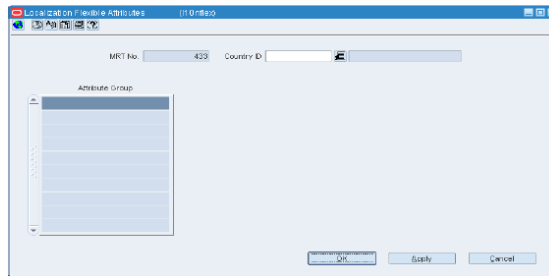
