This Release Notes document is the only component of the RWMS 13.2.0.1 release. The purpose of this Release Notes document is to correct the *Oracle Retail Warehouse Management System Release Notes* for Release 13.2.

## Documentation Release Only

The Oracle Retail Warehouse Management System (RWMS) 13.2.0.1 release is a documentation-only release. There is no code associated with this release identifier. RWMS 13.2 remains the current version of the code.

## Release Notes Updates

The following are updates to *Oracle Retail Warehouse Management System Release Notes* document.

- The description for the Interface to Zebra Label Design Software section from the Technical Enhancements portion of the 13.2 Release Notes is corrected.
- A new Known Issue has been added to the 13.2 list of Known Issues.

## Interface to Zebra Label Design Software

RWMS 13.2 provides retailers with the ability to implement container labeling and ticketing solution using software from Zebra Technologies Corporation (<http://www.zebra.com>). Separate licensing agreements are needed to use the Zebra Components (Zebra Enterprise Connector, ZPL Templates, Zebra Designer and associated artifacts). Using these components, retailers can set up, configure and format their own container labels and tickets. ## Known Issues

Automatic Waves—printing functionality for RMS downloaded Automatic Wave Types is not available in RWMS 13.2.

## Supplemental Documentation

Oracle Retail Warehouse Management System supports customizable printing and reporting requirements using BI Publisher. RWMS barcode printing solution may be used in conjunction with Zebra Technologies barcode printing software and hardware.

Using the ZebraLink Enterprise Connector, BI Publisher forwards report requests to Zebra label and LAN/Shared barcode printers that support Zebra Programming Language (ZPL). The ZebraLink Enterprise Connector has the ability to parse and interpret the XML passed to it by BI Publisher. Label formats supporting various applications can be loaded into the Zebra Enterprise Connector's ZPL repository, facilitating XML printing from Oracle BI Publisher.

### **Oracle Retail Warehouse Management System Label Printing Support and Implementation Overview (Doc ID 1291263.1)**

The *Oracle Retail Warehouse Management System Label Printing Support and Implementation Overview* is a whitepaper document which describes the technical approach to integrate third party labeling and printing solutions to RWMS BI Publisher printing subsystem.
