Documentation Only Release

Note: The Oracle Retail Back Office 13.1.1.1 release is a documentation-only release. There is no code associated with this release identifier. Oracle Retail Back Office 13.1.1 remains the current version of the code.

This Release Notes document is the only component of the Oracle Retail Back Office 13.1.1.1 release. The purpose of this Release Notes document is only to document updates to the *Oracle Retail Back Office Operations Guide* for Release 13.1.1.

Operations Guide Update

This update is required to the *Oracle Retail Back Office Operations Guide* for Release 13.1.1. The following are corrections to the first two paragraphs of Chapter 3, "Extracting Source Code."

Much of this guide deals with the structure and function of Oracle Retail Back Office code, and how you can modify and extend it to serve the needs of your organization. Retailers who wish to make changes to the product, which require the source code, should contact their Oracle representative. All source code distribution requests must be approved, following Oracle's standard Source Code distribution policy.
