To help you get the most out of BEA WebLogic Mobility Server™ and the Device Repository it uses, a selection of manuals are available to guide you from installation through to delivering web-based content and applications to mobile devices...

To Keep up-to-date with Product Releases

Read the *Release Notes* to learn about the new features and enhancements to the WebLogic Mobility Server product.

To Perform a New Installation of WebLogic Mobility Server and the Device Repository

Perform the following procedures in the order outlined:

1. ***BEA WebLogic Mobility Server Installation Guide*** - This guide should be your first stop. Use it as a reference to help you install WebLogic Mobility Server and optional components. The WebLogic Mobility Server installer also installs the Device Repository that the product uses to obtain device profile information.
2. Once you have installed WebLogic Mobility Server and the Device Repository, follow the instructions in the ***BEA WebLogic Mobility Server Administration Guide*** to deploy an application and configure WebLogic Mobility Server in order to get the product up and running.

To Install, Configure and Administer the Device Repository

Chapter 1 of the *Device Repository Guide* explains how to install a Device Repository. Chapter 2 explains how to update the *mis.properties* file to reflect the Device Repository connection details. Chapter 3 serves as a handy day-to-day reference on how to set up and manage the devices and device profiles in the Repository. For cases where the Device Repository is represented as a database, Appendix C describes how to use the Admin Console tool to administer the Repository.

This ***BEA WebLogic Mobility Server Getting Started Guide*** is a tutorial manual is designed to get you started with the WebLogic Mobility Server mobility tags by stepping through a series of short, self-contained projects.
