	Action	Ensure that the Set command in the script run by the TuxShell has the proper format.

	Description	While creating an environment context, the system ran out of memory.
	Action	Check the memory on the system where the TuxShell was running. Increase the amount of memory which is allotted to TuxShell using the finder.

	Description	tuxputenv(3c) returned an error while TuxShell was setting an environment variable.
