Using the Sun JDK 6 with WebLogic Server Web Services

The BEA JRockit © JDK bundled in the WebLogic Server 10.3 Technology Preview is fully compatible with the JAX-WS 2.1 and JAXB 2.1 application programming interfaces (APIs) supported in WebLogic Server 10.3. If you use the default JDK6, no API library customization is required.

The currently available Sun versions of JDK6 (for example: JDK6 Update1, Update2, or Update3) support the earlier JAX-WS 2.0 and JAXB 2.0 APIs. In order to use these versions of the Sun JDK with the WebLogic Server 10.3 Technology Preview web services, you will need to update the API JARs in your JDK6 installation. Copy the following JARs from their WebLogic Server 10.3 locations into your Sun JDK6 endorsed directory:

```
Copy $BEA_HOME/modules/javax.xml.bind_2.1.1.jar to
JDK6_HOME/jre/lib/endorsed
```

```
Copy $BEA_HOME/modules/javax.xml.ws_2.1.1.jar to
JDK6_HOME/jre/lib/endorsed
```
