Note: The steps below are correct as of the date of this release of e*Xpressway Integrator OnRamp. However, these steps can be invalidated by interim changes made to the VeriSign Web site.

2. On the main menu banner at the top of the page, select **Products**.
3. Under the **Retail Services** heading, click the **SSL Certificates** link.
4. Under the **Secure Site Services** heading, click **Buy**.
5. Follow the purchasing instructions on the Web site.
