# Sun Fire Cabinet Redundant Transfer Switch (RTS)


There may be up to two redundant transfer units (RTUs) in a Sun Fire™ cabinet. The RTUs are located in the bottom of the cabinet in the front or rear. The Sun Fire 6800 will always have two RTUs and four RTSs (two each) mounted in its cabinet.

Each RTU assembly contains one pre-installed redundant transfer switch (RTS) module. The second RTS is for redundancy and is optional.

**Note** – If two separate AC power sources (primary and secondary) are not available, and a single AC power source is used, connect ONLY RTS0 to the power source. Connecting RTS0 and RTS1 to a single AC power source (even if separate circuit breakers are used) is not supported and will adversely affect reliability.


## Installing an RTS Module

- 1. Insert the new RTS module into the RTU and ensure proper engagement of the connector in the rear of the module.
- 2. Insert the screw at the bottom of the module and tighten.
- 3. Connect the AC power cable.



4. Power on the wall circuit breaker connected to the RTS module.

5. Turn ON the power switch on the new RTS module.



# Removing an RTS Module

- 1. For systems with redundant RTS modules, skip to Step 3.
- 2. For systems with non-redundant RTS modules, power off the system. Refer to the *Sun Fire 6800/4810/4800/3800 Systems Platform Administration Manual* for complete procedures for powering off the system.
- 3. Turn OFF the power switch on the RTS module that is to be replaced.
- 4. Power off the wall circuit breaker connected to the RTS module that is to be replaced.
- 5. Disconnect the AC power cable from the RTS module that is to be replaced.
- 6. Loosen the screw on the bottom of the RTS module.
- 7. Pull the module straight out.
