Are you ready to install the hardware and software?

Before starting installation, make sure you have reviewed the following Netra™ ct server documentation.

Have your Solaris™ 8 1/01 operating environment CDs ready. (The Solaris operating environment is ordered and shipped separately from the Netra ct server.)

2 Install the Netra ct server hardware.

If you want to install using detailed instructions, refer to the following Netra ct server documentation.

If you want to install using overview instructions only, refer to the following steps.

- a. Prepare your site for installation by checking the room and rack spacing, and DC power.
- b. Mount the Netra ct chassis in a rack.
- c. Connect the DC grounding cable.
- d. Install optional cards, such as I/O cards.
- e. Connect the cables to the CPU card and/or a CPU transition card.
- f. Connect the cables to the alarm card or to the alarm rear transition card.
- g. Connect the cables to any additional cards you installed.
- h. Connect optional external SCSI devices.
- i. Assemble and connect the DC input power cables to the server.
- j. Verify that the locking mechanisms on the power supply units are in the locked (down) position.
- k. Power on the server by pressing the system power button on the system status panel.

The system power LED on the system status panel should light, indicating that the system is completely powered on.

3 Install the Solaris Operating Environment.

As root, install the Solaris 8 1/01 operating environment from the Solaris CDs, including the *Software Supplement for the Solaris Operating Environment* CD, as follows:

- For the Netra ct 800 server, you can install the Solaris operating environment from the CDs or over the network. If you are installing from the CDs, you must have a CD-ROM drive in the removable media module
- For the Netra ct 400 server, you must install the Solaris operating environment over the network

For detailed instructions, refer to the software installation chapter in the *Netra ct Server Installation Guide* and to the Solaris documentation that came with the Solaris CDs.

4 Install and/or configure additional software.

To configure the software for the alarm card, refer to the following Netra ct server documentation.
