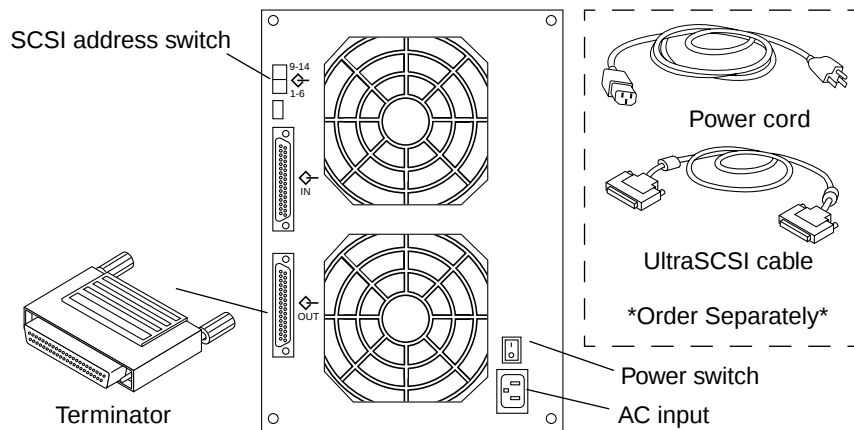
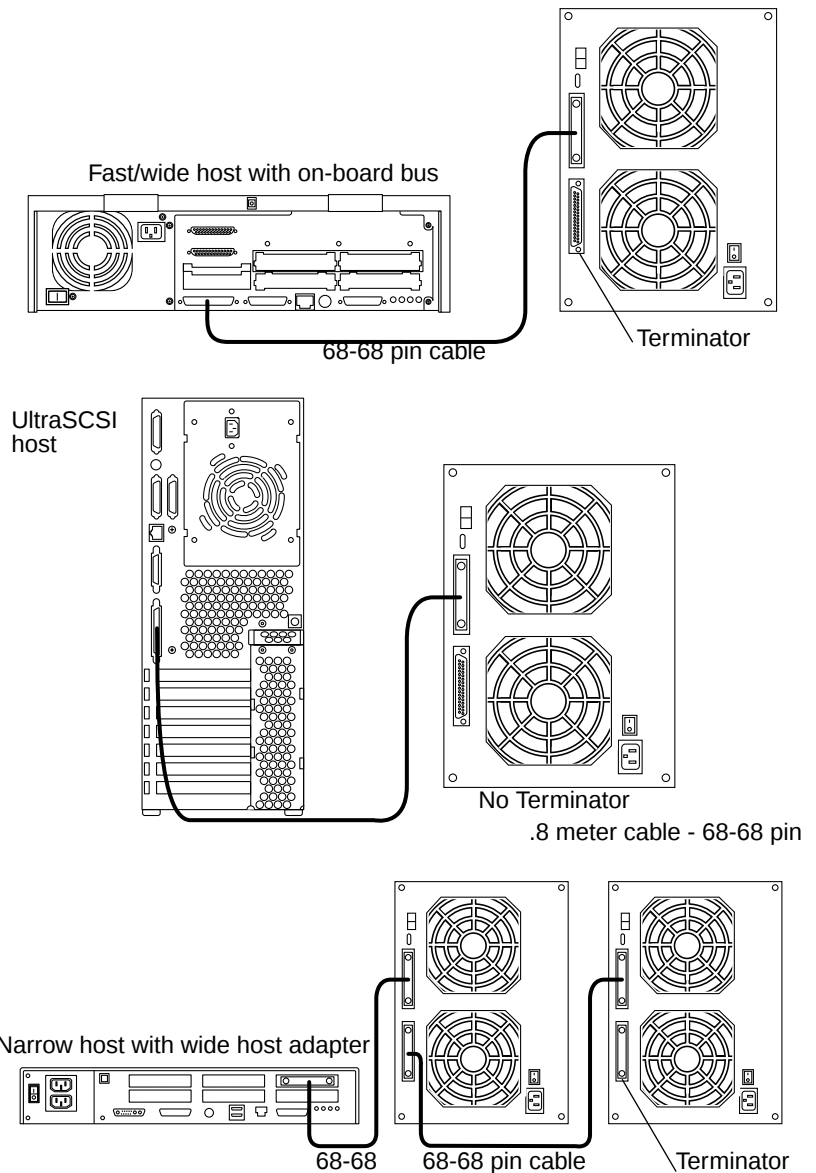




1. **Refer to the Solaris Handbook for SMCC Peripherals or the Solaris AnswerBook online documentation for information on configuring your system for use.**
2. **Read the information in the Sun StorEdge MultiPack User's Guide that applies to your unit.**
Your hardware configuration determines the number and distribution of SCSI addresses available.
3. **Verify the total SCSI bus lengths for your system and all peripherals.**
The total length of all external cables and internal bus lengths will affect the SCSI bus speeds. See the tables in Appendix A of the *Sun StorEdge MultiPack User's Guide*.
4. **Shut down the operating system.**
5. **Determine which SCSI addresses are unused and available on your system.**
6. **Change the addresses of other devices, if necessary.**
7. **Turn off the power to the workstation and the peripherals.**
8. **Connect the cables (ordered separately).**
9. **Turn on the power to the peripherals and then to the workstation.**
10. **Configure the system.**



Note – If you attach more than a single Sun StorEdge MultiPack unit to an UltraSCSI host or use a non-UltraSCSI host without an adapter, the speed will be slower.
