Product Overview

Oracle Enterprise Single Sign-on Universal Authentication Manager enables enterprises to replace the use of native password logon to Microsoft Windows and Active Directory networks with stronger and easier to use authentication methods. The ESSO-UAM system also enhances enterprise security beyond traditional password authentication.


