## Preparing to Install

Please review the preliminary information concerning the installation such as prerequisites and network and software requirements prior to installing the new release.

### Prerequisites

**Upgrades:** Oracle Utilities Work and Asset Management Release 1.8.1.2 is required.

**New Installations:** Please follow the guidelines in the *Oracle Utilities Work and Asset Management Installation Guide for Release 1.9* to install the database and the application server before installing Oracle Utilities Work and Asset Management.

Due to the ongoing nature of software improvement, vendors will issue patches and service packs for the operating systems, application servers and database servers on top of specific versions that Oracle Utilities Work and Asset Management has been tested with.

If it is necessary to apply an upgrade, please do that in a test environment prior to updating the Oracle Utilities Work and Asset Management production environment.

The only exception from this rule is Hibernate software. For this the exact version mentioned in this guide must be installed. Please always check with Oracle Utilities Work and Asset Management support prior to installing Hibernate updates.

Always contact Oracle Utilities Work and Asset Management support prior to applying vendor updates that do not guarantee backward compatibility.

## Oracle Support Policy Regarding VMware
