What's New in Release 20.2.1

AutoVue for Agile has been certified on Windows 7 and AutoVue 20.2.1.

Known Issues

- abc.SLDPRT is not a 3D Model File error displayed while doing digital mockup for the Browse action.

Issue: If the BREP and Mesh versions of SolidWorks files are different and one of the version is not supported, then digital mockup for the Browse action does not work.

Workaround: Save the SolidWorks files again in the version supported by AutoVue. In AutoVue, the SolidWorks versions prior to version 2006 are de-supported file versions.

- The Print menu item prints the contents of the zipped folder rather than the content present in the individual files of the zipped folder.

Issue: If you try to print the individual files from the zipped folder in AutoVue Viewer, the list of files present in the zipped file is printed. The AutoVue Viewer has to list the compressed files in the zipped folder, and has to prompt you to choose the individual file that has to be printed.

Workaround: No workaround available.

- Viewing a redlined zipped files displays the markup incorrectly.

Issue: When you click a redlined file, which has a markup associated with it, the mark up is displayed in the zipped folder. The correct behavior would be that the AutoVue Viewer lists the compressed files in the zipped folder. After that, when you click the redlined file, it should open up that file in another Viewer window along with the markup.

Workaround: No workaround available.

- The message <DMSXmlRequest:ERROR) is displayed as error.

Issue: AutoVue prints out the messages ("<DMSXmlRequest:ERROR>") labeled as error when Agile generates and regenerates thumbnails. These messages do not adversely impact the Agile functionalities of thumbnail generation/regeneration.

Workaround: No workaround available.

AutoVue 20.2.1 Resolved Issues

Issue: Thumbnails were not generated for any format with AutoVue for Tomcat (File Manager) and application server running on Linux.

Root Cause:

vuebean.jar, gluegen-rt.jar, jogl.jar and jvue.jar were present in the AutoVue installed server.

Resolution:

The jar files have been removed from the AV server.

Verification:

1. Login to web client with thumbnail enabled user.
2. Create an item, add attachments in any one of the following formats: dwg, pdf or slddrw.
3. Verify the thumbnails.

Actual Result:

Thumbnails are generated for the attachment based on the format.

Note vuebean.jar should be removed from webfs.war for Agile 9.3.1.x (ie. Tomcat 6.0.18) and Agile 9.3.2 (Tomcat 7.0.26).

Note gluegen-rt.jar, jogl.jar and jvue.jar files should be available in Filemgr lib for Agile 9.3.2 (Tomcat 7.0.26).
