But the same user on production is not able to import the user changes. Updates to the Cross References Equivalent value are saved after the first Save. (30914)
14646104	An error occurred when adding a packaging materials specification and alternate substitute specifications at the same time on a trade specification.	The trade specification is saved successfully. (30973)
14667830	User is able to enter more than 40 characters for Spec Short name in languages other than English. The limit for all languages is 40 characters.	All languages adhere to the 40 character limit. (31025)
14699408	When attempting to copy a testing protocol library, the user receives an unhandled error.	The error no longer occurs. (31058)
14807953	When trying to associate nutrient source to a nutrient for a specification, 'Theoretical' source does not appear as an option from the add icon (+) list on the Nutrient line.	Because 'Theoretical' is on the ADMN > GSM COMMON > Nutrient Source list, it is included on the list of Nutrient Source. (31265)
15858210	When attempting to add nutrients from the Nutrition Panel tab of a nutrient profile after adding two nutrients with the same prefix like 'Folate, food', 'Folate, DFE', the user receives an unhandled error when clicking the Add New button.	Nutrients with the same prefix are successfully added. (31373)
15898118	When the user selects the Tools > Formula Compare option from the Formulation specification page and then selects Snapshots as compare source, the search does not return snapshots that matching the search criteria.	The tool successfully performs formula comparisons between snapshots and formulation specifications. (31399)
16055091	For a trade specification, the user was allowed to enter the current specification in the Supersedes field. Specifications should not be allowed to supersede themselves.	User is not allowed to select the specification in context to supersede itself. (31685)
16037445	A user tried to add an alternate material to a process step, and received an error.	The alternate material is successfully added and the error no longer occurs. (31689)

6.0.0.5.29 (14336915)	This affects Oracle customers, only. Oracle upgrade script incorrectly updated the sequence numbers for component catalog terms causing a stack trace in the UI.	Provided an updated Oracle script to correct the sequence numbers ensuring they are unique. (30505)
6.0.0.6.17 (14851064)	Some custom section data records were not denormalized properly due to data corruption.	Correct sourcing approval info is now stored in the fkroot field so that denorm can pick up the correct custom section associated with the specification related sourcing approval. (31267)
6.1.0.2.1	Hot fix number created but not used.	N/A
6.1.0.2.2 (14828601)	NPD portfolios with a large number of projects time out after 2 minutes resulting in a stack trace.	Performance dramatically increased and portfolios no longer time out. (31385)
6.1.0.2.3 (15924663)	The pointer selects the wrong row when working in the LIO grid. This issue only manifested itself when the IE Browser window was scrolled down the page.	By correcting an issue with the TreeView control, the outer container is now respected, and the pointer now selects the desired row. (31476)
6.1.0.2.4 (15955606)	When a user workflowed a material specification to a new status and then clicked the Edit button, in the Formulation tab, the first %Breakdown description was blanked out.	The description now displays. (31534)

Hot Fix	Issue	Resolution
6.1.0.2.5 (15987566)	The originator is denied access to imported specifications via eQ to GSM push. This only affects users assigned to groups that are not nested under the Global group.	Added 'Read Author Status = Draft' to the permissions grid on the Transient Workflow. This allows users assigned outside the Global group (i.e. groups created at the root level, not under Global) to push from eQ to GSM. (31614)
6.1.0.2.6 (16011527)	When attempting to access a specific formulation specification, the user received an unhandled error.	The error no longer occurs. (31621)
6.1.0.2.7 (15998737)	Cannot create a Numeric Extended Attribute with the 'Cnt' or 'Unit' UOMs due to missing 'Units' category.	Created 'Units' UOM category enabling the ability to create an Extended Attribute with the 'Cnt' or 'Unit' UOM. (31620)
6.1.0.2.8 (16073549)	When attempting to import an update to a custom section name in the Chinese language, the import failed.	The import is now successful. (31672)
6.1.0.2.9 (16111853)	A trade specification owner incorrectly does not have workflow permission when the trade specification was created by another user in a different group.	This issue has been resolved. (31708)
6.1.0.2.10 (16170843)	The Context button on the Formulation tab of formulation specifications was missing in some scenarios.	The button is now displayed. (31711)
6.1.0.2.11 (16211620)	For Oracle DB customers only, when editing a custom section and opening the popup to pick tags to attach to the custom section, the pick list is empty.	Corrected an incompatible blank string for Oracle DB in the ExtendedAttributeDynamicTagFilteredDataSource table. (31741)
6.1.0.2.12 (16270097)	Metrics are not properly displayed in NPD portfolios for users that have [NPD_GLOBAL].	Metrics now appear on NPD portfolios. (31809)
6.1.0.2.13	Hot fix number created but not used.	N/A
6.1.0.2.14 (16396483)	Stack trace when adding an alternate input for certain material inputs.	This issue has been resolved. (31984)
