Tab Groups DO	New Display Object for creating tab groups consisting of child DOs
Verbose Listing DO Options	The Listing Display Object now has many more options for styling listings, including image and image placement options
Dropdown Menu	New Display Object allowing for expandable menu options
Color Gradient support	Gradients can now be set in many display properties
Light Box/Image Zoom	Feature which allows for enlarging of images by the user for closer inspection
Social Media Sharing buttons	Feature which allows for sharing articles via Email, Twitter, Facebook, and Pinterest
Font Size Selector	Feature which allows for increasing and decreasing font size for articles
Margin properties	Feature which allows for setting spacing for any Display Object

Contact support for instructions on adjusting this property name or as a short-term workaround use the tooltip presented when hovering over the property to distinguish them.
4882	Bug	The child DO option 'label', used to label tabs in tab group, is case sensitive in mapper. If you call it 'Label' it doesn't register.
