This release includes new fields and updates for PPACA eligible filings. This release is for L&H Tracker users only.

NEW FEATURES AND ENHANCEMENTS

The following describes the new features and enhancements in this version of Tracker, including those added to Tracker since version 6.6.2. If you have previously updated your Tracker installation to 6.7 or 6.7.4, you will already have some of these new features and enhancements. For more information, please contact *Oracle Support*.

Note The features and enhancements added only apply to Life and Health-specific release.

SERFF

- In the General tab of PSU, two new fields have been added; "Include Exchange Intentions" and "Exchange Intentions" that are available under the field column. This feature is part of L&H tracker, added for initial filing submission and is only available on PPACA eligible filings.
- If "Include Exchange Intentions?" is set to 'Yes', then the "Exchange intentions" field is mandatory for the user.
- For Non Canadian provinces, a new tab is created for displaying a list of states and jurisdictions. There are three fields for each state; HIOS Issuer ID, NCQA Org ID,URAC Application Number. These fields are optional for the user, but recommended for PPACA eligible filings.
