

# 3. Introduction - Dashboard Widgets

The widgets are smaller windows which show data in an optimized form. In a contemporary *UI* version of *FLEXCUBE Direct Banking Application*, the dashboard will have small widgets. These widgets will show minimal data related to main transactions. These widgets will also enable you to initiate transactions with minimal details.

Below **Personal Finance Management Dashboard** screen shows all the widgets displayed in it, followed by the explanation of each widget.



# 4. Financial Overview

The Financial Summary widget will display the separate bar graphs for Assets and Liabilities section with details of Assets and Liabilities available for various assets and liabilities under the respective sections. These will be classified by Account Type. The total of Assets and Liabilities will also get displayed. All the accounts will be sorted by Customer Id in a particular Account Type. The system will display the Finance Summary as follows:

#### **Financial Overview**




I have column will display the details of all the Assets with Amount and Percentage with respect to the Total Asset Amount and Sum Total of all the Assets of the user.

I Owe column will display the details of all the *Liabilities with Amount and Percentage* with respect to the *Total Liability Amount* and *Sum Total* of all the *Liabilities* of the user.

# 5. Budgeting

This widget displays the *Budgets Vs Expenditure* in a minimalistic form. It allows you to view the graphical representation of the *Expenses VS Budgets* set for the categories for which the budgets are maintained.

The graph displays the *Budget Vs Expenditure* for the categories set of top n categories having maximum expenditure.

## **Field Description**

Field Name	Description
Modify	[Action Button] Click <b>Modify</b> to make the changes in the values entered for the desired <i>Categories</i> and <i>Sub-categories</i> .
Compare	[Action Button] Click <b>Compare</b> to compare your existing budget with peers.
View Budget History	[Action Button] Click View Budget History to check the history of the existing budget.
Expand	[Icon] Click the <b>Expand</b> icon to open the Sub-categories.
Collapse	[Icon] Click the <b>Collapse</b> icon to close the Sub-categories.
<< (View Previous)	[Action Button] Click << (View Previous) to view the Expenses Vs Budget for the previous period.
>> (View Next)	[Action Button]  Click >> (View Next) to view the Expenses Vs Budget for the next period.
Category	[Display] This column displays the list of various categories and sub-categories available.
Amount	[Display] This column displays the amount for <i>Expenditure Vs Budget</i> for its corresponding category and sub-category.
Expenditure Graph	[Display] The Expenditure Line Graph is displayed as per the following configurations:  Green – Expenditure upto 50% of Budget  Yellow – Expenditure between 50% - 75% of Budget  Red – Expenditure more than 75% of Budget


