Oracle Data Integrator ELT Framework

Oracle Data Integrator ELT Framework is a collection of schema components and knowledge modules to support the extract, load, and transform of data using Oracle Data Integrator. It enables smooth transfer of data from Oracle Utilities Customer Care and Billing and Oracle Utilities Operational Device Management to the data warehouse in Oracle Utilities Analytics.

In Oracle Utilities Analytics v2.5.0.0.2, the Journalizing Knowledge Module (JKM) has been enhanced to provide support to handle collisions and insert missing updates. This enables the Golden Gate replication process to function smoothly when a record is deleted and a new record (with same ID) is created in the source.

Also, the length of the Product Instance version column in the B1 Product Instance table has been increased to support customers using product name along with the product version.

The existing prebuilt analytics collection covers critical business areas, such as billed usage and revenue distributions.

In Oracle Utilities Analytics v2.5.0.0.2, few navigation and issues in the **Arrears** answers are resolved.

Oracle Utilities Outage Analytics

Oracle Utilities Outage Analytics is a comprehensive collection of prebuilt Oracle Business Intelligence Enterprise Edition (OBIEE) based dashboards and answers that measure and monitor critical metrics related to Oracle Utilities Network Management System. The existing prebuilt analytics collection covers critical business areas, such as outages, restoration status, crew assignments, feeder performance, and more.

In Oracle Utilities Analytics v2.5.0.0.2, the Outage Analytics dashboards are re-organized and enhanced to support additional use cases, such as customer profile, event profile, all customer locations, estimation deviations, and more.

Known Issues

There are two known issues in Oracle Utilities Analytics v2.5.0.0.2 at the time of this release.

- The heat maps in Outage Analytics show single concentration of the outages and do not display the distributed circles/concentrations even when the events are spread out geographically.
- The playback feature in Historical Playback map in Outage Analytics is broken and the playback may not work.
