1. Installation of Database
2. Bootstrap Installation
3. Installation of the Host
4. Installation of the Branch.
5. Setting up Multi Branch Registries

3.1. Installation of Database

The installation of the Database is elucidated in the document - Oracle FLEXCUBE-Core 5.1.0.0.0-RCU_Installation_Guide. By following this document, one will be able to successfully install the database with initial required data and proceed to the installation of the FLEXCUBE Host.

3.2. Bootstrap Installation

This enables to install system and product related data with Chinese localization

so that one can perform banking operations after installation. Please refer the doc - Oracle FLEXCUBE Common Setup & Extract User Guide_v1.2.doc

If we are using Bootstrap, please make sure you are setting the below values correctly in RCU installer and Branch Installer.

- Branch Code – 9999
- Currency Code – 156
- Bank Code – 1
- Entity Code – 1
- Bank IC Code -- 1
