Problem Description			
The Alarms and KPIs Reference Guide does not contain certain recovery information for event 22320 'Invalid peer initiated connection.'			
Impact			
If event 22320 is raised, the customer will not have all relevant recovery information.			
Needed Actions			
In addition to the configuration verification recommended by the Alarms and KPIs Reference Guide, the administration state of the connection should also be checked. For a Responder connection (or Initiator/Responder behaving as Responder) that is administratively down, receipt of Diameter CER will generate this event. The connection may need to be enabled locally or disabled on the remote peer to prevent these events.
