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Chapter 1

Installing the Map Editor

The Map Editor is a utility that enables reading third-party vector mapping data, allows selection of geographic areas-of-interest and production of map files.

This guide provides information on how to install the Oracle Real-Time Scheduler Map Editor in a Windows environment.

Overview

The Oracle Real-Time Scheduler Map Editor is pre-configured to work straight out-of-the-box with minimal configuration changes. Please read through this document thoroughly before beginning your product installation. The information provided in this document is here to guide you through a successful product install. Please complete these tasks in the required order before proceeding to any post-installation steps.

Component

The Oracle Real-Time Scheduler Map Editor system consists of a single component: The Map Editor.

Component Release Version

The Oracle Real-Time Scheduler Map Editor components release versions is: Map Editor-2.1.8.

Installing the Map Editor

To ensure your success in installing or upgrading the Oracle Real-Time Scheduler Map Editor, follow the instructions in the following sections and execute the instructions in each section in order.

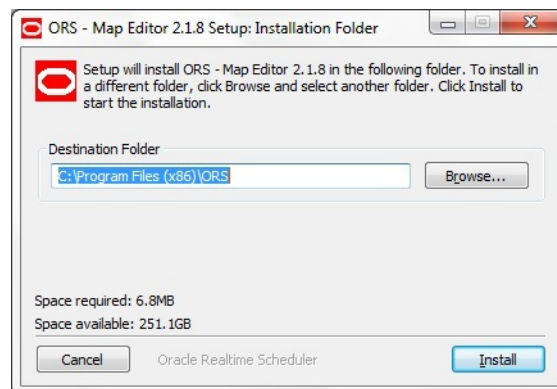
Installation of the Oracle Real-Time Scheduler Map Editor involves the following steps:

1. Downloading the Map Editor installer
2. Running the installer

Map Editor Installation

Use the following procedure to install the Map Editor on each client workstation.

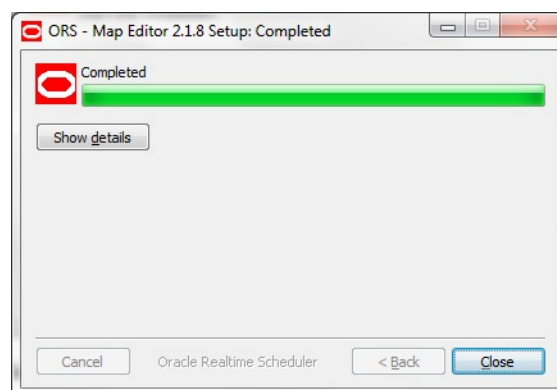
1. Download the Oracle Real-Time Scheduler V2.2.0.0 MapEditor installation package from Oracle Software Delivery Cloud.
2. Copy the Map Editor installer (map_editor-2.1.8-WIN64.exe) from the installation package and place it in your hard drive or on any appropriate media.
3. Double-click the executable.
4. Select the destination folder where the setup must install the Map Editor..



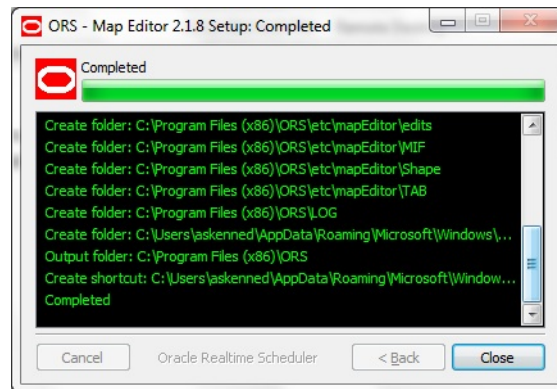
By default the Map Editor is installed under “C:\Program Files (x86)\ORS” directory.

5. You may specify a different location by typing in the exact location or by navigating to the location using the **Browse** button.
6. Click **Install**.

Once set up is complete, the Map Editor 2.1.8 Setup: Completed dialog launches.



7. To check the status and the location of the sub-directories and files installed as part of this setup, click **Show details**. The details are displayed as below.

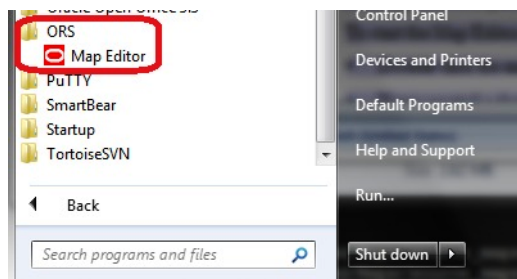


The Map Editor installation is now complete.

Starting the Map Editor

The Map Editor requires no configuration prior to starting the application.

The installer creates a desktop application shortcut to the mapEditor.exe file, under the **Start Menu->ORS** (sub-menu).



To start the Map Editor application:

1. Select **Start->ORS->Map Editor**.

The Map Editor launches.
