Licensing Notes for PeopleSoft Enterprise PeopleTools 8.49

As part of the sales contract with Oracle, what products you can install and use and how you use them is part of the licensing agreement. That agreement contains information related to your overall PeopleSoft application license. This document contains licensing notes and reminders intended more for product implementation teams to help them determine if additional products need to be licensed to achieve the ultimate goals of the PeopleSoft system.

Note. Where third party products are discussed, no specific version number is mentioned, as these can change due to product updates outside the PeopleSoft release cycle. You should *always* consult the Supported Platforms database on Customer Connection to determine what product versions are supported with your version of PeopleTools.
