This document highlights the major changes for Release 17.0 of Oracle Retail Xstore Suite.

## **Overview**

Oracle Retail Xstore Suite includes the following products.

#### **Oracle Retail Xstore Point of Service**

Oracle Retail Xstore Point of Service is a point-of-sale application that provides the capabilities to carry out day-to-day transactions and conduct daily store activities. Tasks such as scanning items, applying price adjustments, tendering, and printing receipts as well as processing returns and web orders can be performed. Store operations including opening the store, managing registers and tills, and closing the store can be handled through Oracle Retail Xstore Point of Service.

#### **Oracle Retail Xstore Office**

Oracle Retail Xstore Office is a central web-based management console that provides for the effortless management of the data and configurations that empower your associates. The user interface within Oracle Retail Xstore Office provides streamlined functionality that guides users through configuration changes, data changes, and deployments. Granular security access can create a custom experience for users of all access levels. Multiple support tools and alerts enable IT leaders to take a proactive approach to managing multiple installations.

## **Functional Enhancements**

The following functional enhancements are included in this release.

# **Omnichannel Data Privacy Application Programming Interface Tool**

The new Omnichannel Data Privacy API Tool that has been integrated with Xstore Office allows you to perform the following actions related to data privacy:

- End User Access and Other Requests (Data Access): The API tool allows you to request personal information for a specified person. The response to the request contains all personal data for the person.
- Data Removal: The API tool allows you to remove personal data for a specified person. The response to the request indicates whether the removal was successful.
- Anonymization: When removing personal data for a specified person, the system replaces the personal data with blank fields.

**Note:** Brazil is not supported in Xstore POS 17.0.

## **Xstore Point of Service**

Xstore POS 17.0 added the following functionality:

#### **Customer Consent**

When collecting information about a customer, Xstore POS can be configured to ask the customer for their consent to having their data collected.

#### Inventory Counts While a Store is Open

Xstore POS now allows users to perform inventory counts while a store is open. When a count is being performed while the store is open, shipping and receiving for the

count items is disabled. When the count is submitted, Xstore POS creates an inventory snapshot that can be used to validate the count. Xstore POS then makes adjustments to the inventory to account for inventory movement that may have occurred during the count.

#### **Guided Selling Button**

Xstore POS now provides a button that calls a URL for guided selling. This URL launches the retailer's guided selling website or application and retrieves a list of items to sell or order within Xstore POS.

#### **Arabic Language Receipt Printing**

Receipts can be printed in Arabic in HTML or on an Epson TM-T88V receipt printer.

#### Scan Items at Login Prompts

Item lookups can be performed while Xstore POS is at a Register or Back Office login prompt.

#### **Airside Enhancements**

The following enhancements have been made to airside functionality in Xstore POS:

**Information from Multiple Flights** Airside stores can collect flight information for multiple flights from one boarding pass.

**Discounts** Xstore POS can apply discounts for staff or arriving passengers.

**Disable Tax Free** Tax-free sales can be disabled for customers who are not eligible for tax-free shopping.

#### Tax Free Shopping Enhancements

The support for Tax Free Shopping has been enhanced in order to comply with additional legal requirements, and for tighter integration with the Tax Free Providers. Additionally, some country-specific enhancements have been made, such as enhanced validations and additional mandatory fields.

#### **Xstore Mobile Point of Service Enhancements**

Xstore Mobile POS functionality has been extended to include the following in version 17.0.

#### Thin Client Version

Xstore Mobile POS can be installed as a thin client on a Workstation 610. In addition to all the functions available on the tablet version of Xstore Mobile POS, the thin client also provides the following functionality:

- Count a cash drawer
- Perform a mid-day deposit
- Perform a till audit
- Attach a till
- Remove a till

Local hardware support

#### Use of the Back Button

Pressing the Back button in Xstore Mobile POS prompts the user whether to save current work before canceling an action.

#### **Airside Enhancements**

Xstore Mobile POS now includes specialized functionality for airside retail stores in airports.

#### **Additional Register Functionality**

Several features of Xstore POS desktop register functionality have been extended to Xstore Mobile POS.

The 17.0 version of Xenvironment includes the following enhancements:

#### **Eliminated Corporate Password**

Users are assigned permissions, rather than using a corporate password to access managerial functions.

# **EFTLink Integration Enhancements**

Xstore POS (including Xstore Mobile POS) has been further integrated with EFTLink, allowing Xstore POS to take further advantage of the functionality available through EFTLink.

#### **Check Validation**

Checks tenders for Xstore POS can now be authorized through EFTLink.

This feature is available with AJB FiPay.

#### **Card Not Present Payments**

Xstore POS supports Card Not Present (CNP) payments through EFTLink. This allows customers to make payments for transactions over the phone.

This feature is available with AJB FiPay, Adyen, Cayan, Tender Retail, and Verifone Point.

#### **Cancel Card Payments**

An Xstore POS card payment that is in progress can now be canceled through a button in Xstore POS.

This feature is available with Adyen, AJB Fipay, and Verifone Point.

#### **Dynamic Currency Conversion Stores Extra Fields**

Xstore POS now stores the following data that is returned from EFTLink. This data is stored as part of the Xstore POS transaction and is included in the POSLog:

- Currency Code
- Currency Amount
- Currency Exchange Rate

This feature is available with Adyen.

Xstore POS is now integrated with the following features in Oracle Retail Order Broker Cloud Service:

- Edit an order before tendering and submission to Order Broker
- Accept or reject either line items or entire orders for fulfillment

- Convert items to Order Broker order items
- Override the local copy of an order

Note that the legacy Order Broker processes may be permitted to remain in place.
