This document highlights the major changes for Release 7.1.3 of Oracle Retail Xstore Point of Service.

Note: The rebranding for the latest version of this documentation set is in development as part of post MICROS acquisition activities. References to former MICROS product names may exist throughout the existing documentation set.

Release Overview

This document contains the release notes for Oracle Retail Xstore Point of Service version 7.1.3 components. These release notes cover new features and enhancements for this version of Oracle Retail Xstore Point of Service, Oracle Retail Xstore Point of Service Mobile, Oracle Retail Xstore Office, Oracle Retail Xstore Payment, and Oracle Retail Xenvironment.

Important Information

Any customer currently running an earlier version of Xstore Point of Service 7.1 and/or Xenvironment 7.1 should upgrade to Xstore Point of Service 7.1.3 and Xenvironment 7.1.3 as soon as possible.

Note: You must also upgrade Xenvironment to version 7.1.3. Xstore Point of Service 7.1.3 will not communicate with an earlier version of Xenvironment.

You must also upgrade Apache to version 2.4.10 (build 57).

You must upgrade Jetty to build 26, or upgrade Tomcat to build 19.

If you are using Xstore Payment, you must also upgrade Xstore Payment to version 3.2.

- Tender Retail to Chase Paymentech (credit and debit)

- First Data TransArmor via Rapid Connect (credit and debit)

Inventory	RXPS-14447	Comments for an inventory adjustment are saved to the database and the POSLog.
User Interface	RXPS-14675	Unavailable menu options are grayed out.
Replication	RXPS-14685	Replication publisher performance to Oracle databases is improved.
Database	RXPS-14696	A script checking for the existence of a job on an Oracle database will complete successfully.
DataLoader	RXPS-14808	Added support to DataLoader for commission modifier record type.
Post Void	RXPS-14835	Escaping out of a post void does not create an orphan transaction.
No Sale	RXPS-14877	After escaping out of a no sale transaction, another no sale transaction can be performed.
