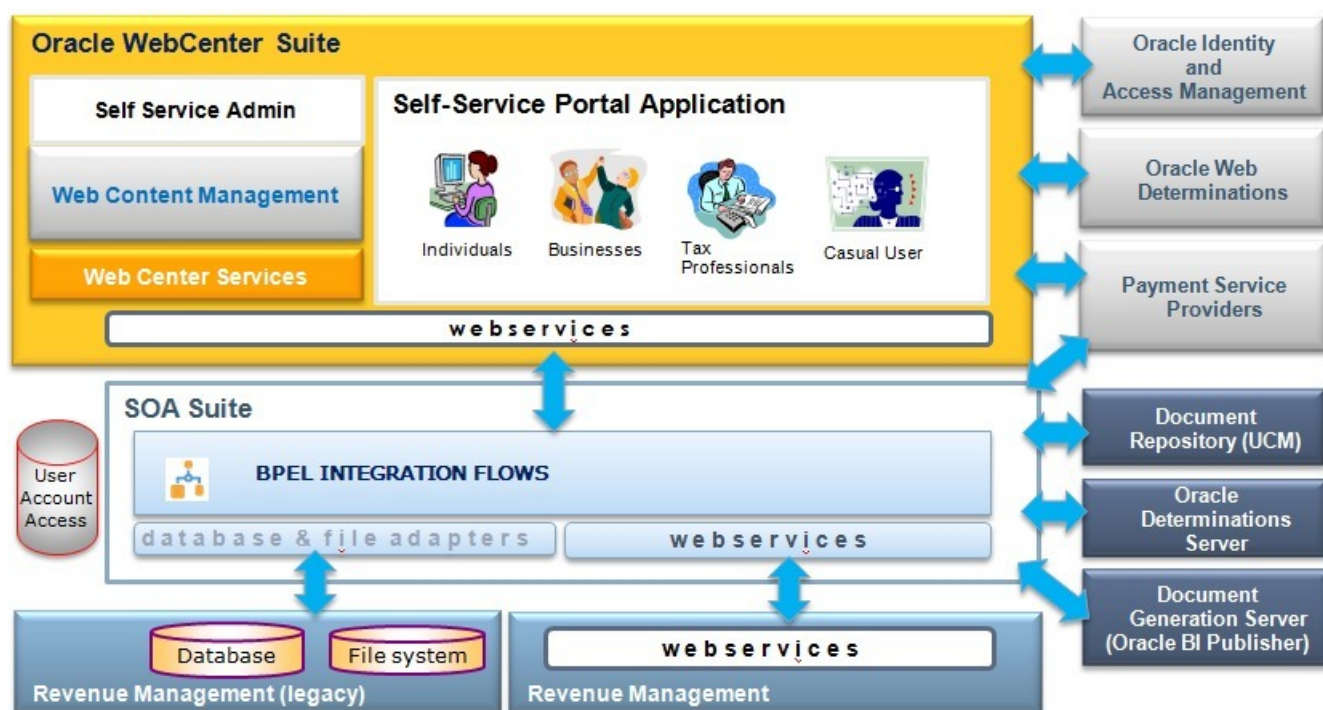

Chapter 7

Installing the Self Service Application

Refer to the individual component installation guides for installation instructions for the software products mentioned in the first part of this procedure. Links to the individual product installation guides are provided in the *Oracle Public Sector Revenue Management Self Service Installation Guide*.

Install the following prior to installing PSRMSS:

1. Install database server software.
2. Install database schemas using RCU.
3. Install an empty MDS Schema using RCU.
4. Install WebLogic.
5. Install WebCenter.
6. Install WebLogic.
7. Install SOA Suite.
8. Install UCM Suite.

To install Oracle Public Sector Revenue Management Self Service V1.1.0.1.0:

9. Configure a Domain for PSRMSS.
10. Install the PSRMSS-PSRM Integration Flows using the installer.
11. Install PSRMSS using the PSRMSS installer.
